

AHR RallyCross Bounty Hunter

What is it?

Bounty Hunter is a program specific to AHR RallyCross that rewards both drivers improving their skill and vehicle, as well as drivers who can consistently stay on top of their game. Drivers will be rewarded in credits that may be exchanged for registration fees at AHR RallyCross events.

How does it work?

After a driver wins their second consecutive event within a class, a “bounty” of \$20 will be placed on them for the following event. For every consecutive win, the bounty will increase by \$20. If the driver is beaten, the bounty is awarded to whomever wins. If the end of the season arrives and the driver is not bested, they will collect the entire bounty, to be applied at AHR RallyCross events for the following season.

For example: John Doe wins AHR RX Event 1 and Event 2 of the current season. John has a bounty on him for \$20 at Event 3. On the third event, John's exceptionally fast sister, Jane, co-drives his car and wins. Jane is awarded \$20 in credits, and can use them to come back for Event 4. Jane comes back and wins Event 4 and also Event 5. Jane now has a \$40 bounty on her in event 6. If Jane wins, she will collect the \$40. If Jane loses, whoever wins will collect \$40.

Other rules:

No show – If a driver with a bounty on them does not attend an event, the bounty is forfeit.
