I. <u>PURPOSE</u>

It is the policy of ClinicalConnect HIE to ensure the use of – and participant use of – standardized change management methods and procedures for the effective handling of any IT infrastructure changes. This is to minimize negative impact to day to day business operations, production systems, and/or other downstream systems.

II. SCOPE

This policy applies to ClinicalConnect HIE staff and its Participants.

III. <u>DEFINITIONS</u>

"Participant" is an organization (including physician practice) that has signed a Data Exchange Agreement with the ClinicalConnect HIE.

"Service Provider" is an organization that has signed a support agreement with the ClinicalConnect HIE to provide technology related services necessary to operate the health information exchange.

IV. POLICY

- A. ClinicalConnect HIE its service providers, and participants shall follow IT best practices for production change control.
- B. Changes shall be planned, authorized, and communicated to all affected parties with adequate advanced notice.
- C. All changes shall be tested, documented, and validated by the requestor before being implemented in a production environment.
- D. All changes shall be approved in advance prior to production implementation.
