This year, above all, we honored donors, who continue to be the bedrock of our success, amazing us with their limitless passion. We received dozens of donations that were in recognition of accomplishments, expressions of grief in time of loss, to memorialize a mother, father or friend and for numerous other reasons. MADISON COUNTY COMMUNITY FOUNDATION INCORPORATED

Initiative launched from blueprint to reality with \$175,000 from the U.S. Department of Justice this year, thanks in part to the Madison County Community Foundation. The program partners law enforcement, social organizations

and community members to "weed out" violent crime, drug abuse and gang activity and "seed" human services and neighborhood restoration.

"I was born and raised here. I was gone about 30 years and came back after 9/11. There was trash everywhere," says Tessa Etchison, a resident and volunteer for the Riley School neighborhood, one of five police beats covered by Weed and Seed.

The Anderson City Police, the City of Anderson's Community Development Department and many other agencies, including the Wilson Boys & Girls Club and the Urban League of Madison County, participate in Weed and Seed.

"It streamlines the process and eliminates the frustration," Etchison says. "People can take ownership of their little slice of heaven. Drug dealers don't last very long

in this neighborhood."

Kim Townsend of the Anderson Community Development Department endorses the program in her work and also as a resident in the Riley School

neighborhood.

"I can't say enough about how their involvement has helped us," Townsend says about Weed and Seed. "We're training people and we have youth programming going on."

Joel Sandefur of the Anderson Police Department credits the Madison County Community Foundation for helping in the grant process and providing ongoing support.

"It's not a program or a plan, it's a philosophy of collaborative effort," Sandefur says. "We are seeing over a period of time, with our concentrated effort, crime go down..."

Sandefur says the positive impact of Weed and Seed will continue.

"Out of the success of this grant have come many grants." he says.

The *dea of a fund



by women for the benefit of women started as a conversation among friends, who brought their dream to the Madison County Community Foundation. As a result, this

year The Century Club was born.

Mary Jo Lee, CEO of Alternatives, Incorporated, is a founding member of Women in Philanthropy, and one of the women who helped initiate The Century Club.

"We have established The Women's Fund at the Madison County Foundation. We began with 100 women who were asked to donate \$100 each," Lee says. "We especially want to encourage young women to become involved."

The women's initiatives through the Foundation aim to help women connect with causes and also provide them recognition for their efforts.

The Madison County Community Foundation organized the group, hosts the meetings and appointed Jeanne Lee as volunteer chairperson.

This year's annual Women in Philanthropy luncheon featured keynote speaker Judy O'Bannon, former First Lady of Indiana, who spoke on "A Community of Caring Women."

Rebekah Logan, 34, a married mother of two children who works at Eli Lilly and Company, also volunteers with the Leadership Academy of Madison County.

"Judy was able to impress upon everyone in the room that we can all do just a little bit to make a difference. Every year the luncheon has been a packed house of women of all ages and at all levels of involvement. You have to prioritize philanthropy and helping in the community just as highly as some of your personal commitments," Logan says.

"I don't think The Century Club could have happened without the leadership of The Madison County Community Foundation," says Mary Jo Lee.



"I believe that we

are all creatures of habit," says Jim Willey, Superintendent of Alexandria Community Schools. "The only way we can grow is to experience how other districts and educators are creating and adapting their instructional paradigm." This year, Willey and the four other Madison County school superintendents joined with leaders in a variety of fields to participate in a Foundation-sponsored panel discussion hosted by Anderson University

The event sparked a forward momentum for school change that attracted the attention of



officials in Indianapolis. Because of the Madison County Community Foundation's record of successfully convening leaders, \$50,000 in grant money was awarded

from the National Governor's Association, which is funded by the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation.

"One of the people said that it was the first time so many influential people from Madison County, from so many different areas of expertise, had gotten together for one common goal," says Joe Kilmer, Foundation president.

The format allowed educators to receive constructive criticism, see the "bigger picture" and "break down the classroom walls that isolated us," Willey notes.

The grant money is earmarked to study high school reform models

"I believe the schools are often behind the technology curve. We've been pretty good at putting computers in front of students. It's the integration of applications into their classes that we need to improve upon," Willey says.

"The Foundation has provided the role as a convener of ideas and leadership and has remained neutral, allowing discussion and ideas to develop out of the participating organizations."

The Madison County Community Foundation board views educational reform as priority number one and the conversation has only begun.

Jake Isenburg was awarded a college scholarship from the Lilly Endowment by the Madison County Community Foundation. Expectations for Jake, as well as all the foundation's Lilly scholars, have always remained high.

But some might consider Jake an overachiever. In 2002 he graduated magna cum laude with a BS in chemical engineering from Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology, where professors encouraged him to pursue more education.

"I absolutely loved my time at Rose, which was made available by the Lilly Scholarship and the good people at The Madison County Community Foundation," Jake says.

By 2006 Jake had earned a PhD in bioengineering from Clemson University in South Carolina, specializing in cardiovascular and vascular devices.

These days Jake works at Vatrix Medical, Inc. in Minnesota with medical technologies he and his colleagues invented and patented while he was at Clemson, where he was an adjunct professor.

One of his fields deals with improving chemical treatments for replacement heart valves for patients. The other is associated with treating aneurysms, which he says



are one of the top 10 leading causes of death in the U.S. for older males.

"A large part of what I do is experimental surgeries in animals—so far, we've been pretty effective in stopping aneurysms from progressing, which is pretty ground-breaking stuff," Jake says.
