#### **Illness Notification**

- We are now utilizing MyBrightDay to inform parents of the confirmed illnesses per building.
- MyBrightDay lets us select specific classrooms instead of sending a mass message to all parents on our distribution list.
- It is important to notify the center when your child has a confirmed illness, so we can inform ABM to perform a deep cleaning in your child's classroom.
- Teachers also clean all items that children may come in contact with to prevent spreading of germs.

# Hand washing

 We ask that parents please wash your hands when you enter your child's classroom to avoid spreading of germs. Teachers may ask you to wash hands if you do not do so upon entering.

#### Siblings in Classrooms

- Only parents are able to go into infant classrooms.
- Please do not leave your child(ren) unattended. We (Bright Horizons) are liable if something were to happen to them on our campus.
- We suggest that you drop off the oldest child first.
- Parent asked, "What if she has older children who do not attend the center?" We ask that you call ahead and we will inform the classroom to get your child ready for you.

## Parking Lot Etiquette

- NAEYC and Licensing requires that there are no cars left running unattended on campus.
- Points will be deducted off of our score if observed by NAEYC.
- Phone calls are forbidden during carpool hours. They are a distraction in the parking lot and we want to keep all staff, children and parents safe on our premises.

We ask that your child be fully dressed during carpool. Please park and put the items back on your child before coming through the carpool line.
