Over 1.5 million people have experienced CicLAvia. It's the biggest open streets event in the USA!

Participants come from 75% of all zip codes in Los Angeles that represent 80% of the population of the City of Los Angeles.



CicLAvia has impacted local and regional transportation policy related to pedestrians and bikes.

CicLAvia improves air quality by reducing harmful air emissions over 50 percent during CicLAvia days.



CicLAvia has been opening streets across Los Angeles County since 2010, producing 27 CicLAvia events with over 180 miles having been traversed throughout the city's and the region's diverse communities: the San Fernando Valley, Culver City, Venice, Mar Vista, Wilshire Blvd., Koreatown, MacArthur Park, South LA, Echo Park, Chinatown, Little Tokyo, Boyle Heights, Historic Downtown, East LA, Pasadena, Pacoima, Arleta, Panorama City, San Pedro, Wilmington, Atwater Village, Glendale, and Southeast Cities.

CicLAvia has five times more people using its temporary park space during event day than are using all of the other parks in the city of Los Angeles combined.
