



# BROOKSTONE SUMMER FAQs

## WHO MAY ATTEND SUMMER CAMP?

Everyone is invited to take part in Brookstone Summer. Please note that several camps have age minimums/limits, which must be followed. Campers must be the required age at the time of camp. All attendees must be potty trained. For Cougar Cubs, campers must be enrolled at Brookstone for the 2025-2026 School year to participate in camps.

## HOW AND WHEN DO I SIGN UP?

You may sign up any time prior to and including the first day the individual camp begins if space is available. Registration is online via the Brookstone School website. We are unable to accept registrations over the phone.

## HOW MAY I PAY FOR CAMP?

The preferred and fastest method of payment is online through the Brookstone web site by using a Visa or MasterCard. Payment is due in full prior to the start of camp. No credit will be extended.

## WHAT IS THE CANCELLATION POLICY?

Camp cancellations will not be refundable if made less than 10 days prior to the camp.

Brookstone Summer reserves the right to cancel any camp that does not meet the minimum attendance requirement.

## WHAT TIME ARE THE SUMMER CAMP SESSIONS?

Cougar Cubs early drop off (at 8:30 AM) is available for an additional fee of \$20 per camp session. Camps run from 9:00AM - 1:00PM, Monday through Thursday, and include lunch each day.

Cougar Kids (Rising Kindergarten - Rising 1st graders) runs from 9:00AM - 12:30PM Monday - Thursday. Early drop off is available at 8:30AM for no additional fee.

Camp B (Rising 2nd graders - Rising 5th graders) runs from 8:30AM - 12:30PM Monday through Thursday. Parents can select between two camp categories for their child based on their age (Rising 2nd - Rising 3rd or Rising 4th - Rising 5th).
