2. Air tickets

Air tickets are purchased independently after obtaining a visa. Please choose a refundable rate. Before purchasing air tickets, please coordinate the dates and prices with the organiser: +918919232411 (Mr Anand Roy). After approval, buy the tickets yourself and send the payment receipt. The refund will be credited to your partner account in the back office within 7 days after completion of the trip. If you fail to show up for your flight for any reason or are denied a visa, no refund will be made.

3. Visa

The visa is issued independently, the purpose of your trip is tourism. Before you start applying for a visa, agree on the planned costs for its issuance with the organiser. Once your visa is approved, send the payment receipt. The refund will be credited to your partner account in the back office within 7 days after completion of the trip.

4. Accommodation

The hotel for the duration of the entire official program in Moscow is booked and paid for by the organiser, breakfast is included in the price. If you want to arrive earlier or leave later and stay in the hotel at a group rate, contact the organiser to check available rooms and make payment in advance. If for some reason you are unable to arrive at the hotel, a refund can only be made 7 days before your planned check-in.

5. Transfer from the airport

Upon arrival in Moscow, you will be met by a transfer service with an English-speaking driver.

6. Mobile service/Internet

Upon check-in, you will be given a SIM card of a Russian mobile company.

7. Currency exchange

We recommend that you take cash dollars with you (rupees are not exchanged in Russia) at the rate of 100 dollars per day.

1. Baggage rules:

1.1 It is prohibited for passengers to carry the following dangerous substances and objects on board the aircraft in checked baggage and in things carried by passengers: magnetized objects, explosives and weapons, poisonous and toxic substances, flammable liquids, flammable solids, radioactive materials, compressed and liquefied gases, oxidizing substances and organic peroxides, toxic substances, caustic and corrosive substances, small personal mobility aids powered by lithium batteries, and other dangerous substances, objects and cargo that can be used as a weapon of attack against passengers and aircraft crew, as well as posing a threat to the flight of the aircraft.

1.2 It is allowed to carry in luggage: household knives (scissors) with a blade length over 60 mm; alcoholic beverages containing more than 24%, but not more than 70% alcohol by volume in containers with a capacity of no more than 5 liters, in containers intended for retail trade – no more than 5 liters per passenger; liquids and alcoholic beverages with an alcohol content by volume of no more than 24%; aerosol sprays intended for sports or household purposes, with the release valves of the cans protected by caps from spontaneous release of the contents in containers with a capacity of no more than 0.5 kg or 500 ml – no more than 2 kg or 2 liters per passenger; medical thermometer containing mercury in a standard case – one item per passenger.

1.3 Items allowed to carry in hand luggage: a medical thermometer that does not contain mercury; mercury blood pressure monitor in a standard case – one per passenger; a mercury barometer or manometer, packed in an airtight container and sealed with the sender's seal; disposable lighters - one per passenger; dry ice for cooling perishable foods – no more than 2 kg per passenger; 3% hydrogen peroxide – no more than 100 ml per passenger; liquids, gels and aerosol sprays classified as non-hazardous: in containers with a capacity of no more than 100 ml (or equivalent capacity in other units of volume measurement), packed in a securely closing transparent plastic bag with a volume of no more than 1 liter – one bag per passenger; containers with a capacity of more than 100 ml are not accepted for transportation even if the container is only partially filled, with the exception of: medicines, special dietary foods, baby food, including breast milk, in the amount necessary for the duration of the flight.
