## **Gestational 1 Hour Glucose Tolerance Screen**

## What do I need to know about the Glucose Tolerance Screen?

No preparation is usually needed for the screening test done during pregnancy. This test can be done at any time of the day; therefore you do not need to limit food or fluids before the test.

## What will happen during my Gestational 1 Hour Glucose Tolerance Screen?

At the Lab:

- You will be given the Glucola concentration prescribed by your physician. You must drink this within 5 minutes. Timing begins following ingestion of the Glucola.
- Do not eat during the test (no mints, gum, or smoking). You may drink only water during this time.
- Your blood will be collected 1 hour after the ingestion of the glucola.
- If vomiting occurs, test will need to be canceled and rescheduled at a later date.
