Frequently Asked Questions:

- **Does the Jeannette Cathy Children's Center accept CAPS?**
 - As a NAEYC accredited, client-based center, we are not able to accept CAPS. Childcare centers that accept CAPS must be open to the public.
- **What legal documentation is required for a foster child to enroll at the center?**
 - Guardians must provide the document(s) that grants legal guardianship and decision-making authority over the child. Bright Horizons' legal department reviews the documentation to ensure proper permissions are on file for enrollment. The JCCC Enrollment Manager will reach out if any additional documentation is required.
- **Can outside therapists meet with the children at the JCCC?**
 - Outside therapists are able to work with children at the center as long as we have a signed Therapist Visit Release form on file. Connect with a Bright Horizons staff member at the front desk to obtain this form.
- **For families looking to foster/adopt, what is the registration process if the name, DOB, and desired start date is unknown?**
 - All families must first go through the Service Gateway to be approved for care at the center. Upon approval, families can reach out to the Enrollment Manager for their individual next steps.
