Referees must dress according to official JJIF referee dress rules

5 Right to participate and categories

All competitors must have their personal identification from country.

Each country may have two athletes per category. The event will be held in the following **JJIF Adult (+18) Disciplines:**

Fighting System

Jiu-Jitsu

Duo System

Para Jiu-Jitsu

The participants accept the WADA code and follow the JJIF Anti-Doping regulations. Doping test can and will be done!

6 Fee

The registration fee is \$120 USD per participant. Participant may choose to do one additional discipline for an additional cost of \$20 USD.

7 Hotel/Transport/Arrival

The official hotel is Courtyard by Marriott in Birmingham/Hoover; 1824 Montgomery Highway, South Hoover, Alabama, 35244. You must register using the group rate link to receive the discount (\$170 USD plus taxes). This rate is per room, not per person.

8.1 Coaches

All official coaches should receive their accreditation cards during accreditation. Teams without an official coach will participate without coaching (no athlete or other officials will be allowed to enter the field of play unless they register as coaches).

At least one Coach or Medic per JJNO must prove the participation in the coach seminar of WADA or a similar course.
