HOLLYWOOD BOWL 2005 PARK & RIDE Fact Sheet

PARK & RIDE:

Park & Ride, from 15 Southern California locations, is a convenient and safe way to attend Hollywood Bowl concerts – and, it's easy. Not only does Park & Ride allow visitors to park close to their neighborhoods, free-of-charge, but its buses also drop passengers off at the main entrance of the Bowl. Following each performance, Park & Ride buses return patrons quickly to their supervised Park & Ride lot, allowing them to avoid parking problems and traffic jams. Scheduled departures are listed in Bowl brochures and online at hollywoodbowl.com.

PURCHASING PARK & RIDE TICKETS

Park & Ride tickets (\$2.50 each way) to the Bowl are available at 15 Park & Ride locations on concert nights or may be purchased in advance at the Hollywood Bowl Box Office or online. Tickets are also available through Ticketmaster, and by credit card phone order at 213.480.3232, for an additional service charge. Last year's successful promotion continues this season, offering riders in El Monte and East LA a voucher for two free tickets to selected Hollywood Bowl concerts when they use Park & Ride.

PARK & RIDE LOCATIONS

Hollywood Bowl *Park & Ride* locations for 2004 include: Sherman Oaks (Westfield Shoppingtown Fashion Square at 14006 Riverside Dr.); Westwood (Federal Building at 11000 Wilshire Blvd.); Chatsworth (Chatsworth Metrolink Station at 21510 Devonshire St.); Westchester (Westchester Shopping Center at 6212 W. Manchester Ave.); Pasadena (Parking lot at northeast corner of Ramona & Marengo Sts.); El Monte (El Monte Bus Station at 3501 Santa Anita Ave.); Torrance (Wilson Community Park at 2000 N. Crenshaw Blvd.); Santa Monica (Santa Monica DMV at 2235 Colorado Ave.; Bus stop on Colorado Ave.); East Los Angeles (East L. A. College stadium parking lot at 1301 Avenida Cesar Chavez); Lakewood (Lakewood Center mall at Lakewood Blvd. and Candlewood St.); Downey (Metro Green Line station parking lot at 12801 Lakewood Blvd.); Culver City (Public parking lot at 3844 Watseka Ave.); Arcadia (Arcadia Park Parking lot

at 405 S. Santa Anita Ave.); **Carson** (Carson Civic Center parking lot at 701 Carson St.); and **Rowland Heights** (Schabarum Regional Park at 17250 E. Colima Rd.).

BOWL SHUTTLE

The Bowl Shuttles depart from close-to-the-Bowl locations, offering another drop-off alternative for patrons who live or work near the Hollywood Bowl. Patrons wishing to use this service can simply drive to one of four locations, park for free or low-cost (at the Hollywood & Highland lot, parking is \$2 for four hours with validation from shops, restaurants, cinemas, or nightclubs), and catch a shuttle bus to the front entrance. Bowl Shuttle tickets are only \$3.00 per person, round-trip (various Hollywood & Highland restaurants offer a free shuttle coupon).

BOWL SHUTTLE LOCATIONS

The four 2004 Bowl Shuttle locations are: the Ventura Lot (10801 Ventura Blvd.); Ventura Annex Lot (10601 Ventura Blvd.); LA Zoo Lot (5333 Zoo Dr.); and Hollywood & Highland Lot (6801 Hollywood Blvd.). Shuttles are wheelchair accessible and leave every 10–20 minutes. The last shuttle departs at the concert start time.
