Explore STEAM Programs at JCPL This Summer

FRANKLIN, Ind. – Johnson County Public Library will be taking STEAM programs to the next level this summer, thanks to a generous donation from Duke Energy.

Each of our branches will be kicking off the summer with an interactive demonstration presented by WonderLab Museum of Science, Health and Technology.

For the first time, we will be offering STEAM day camps at each of our branches in June and July. Create and Play Code Camps are designed for children and teens in grades 5-9. Kids will learn coding skills to create mini games and play them with fellow campers.

RTV6 Chief Meteorologist, Kevin Gregory will return to the library to host hands-on experiments and share about Indiana weather.

The grant also funded equipment for a stop animation and podcasting kit. Equipment for the kit will include a green screen, cameras, iPads, materials for stop animation and a microphone.
