


## STATE SENATOR ERIN HOUCHIN

- When the legislature adopts a new state budget during the 2017 session, which one of the following do you think should be the top priority?


  - **BUDGET FUNDING** A. Addiction treatment to address the drug epidemic

  - F. Increasing technology funding for schools




Do you support or oppose giving parents of children with special needs the option to use state educational funding for services such as school choice, tutoring or online courses?





Do you support or oppose requiring law enforcement to collect a DNA sample from criminal suspects in addition to their fingerprints?








