My household is being excluded because someone has been...

EXPOSED



	Why?	 Household spread is a leading cause of transmission. Exposed individuals are instructed by public health authorities to quarantine.
14	How long?	Your household will not be allowed in the center for at least 14 days.
9 3-	Can we come back sooner?	No. COVID-19 has a 14 day incubation. A doctor cannot clear an individual to return because the doctor cannot determine whether an exposed person will become positive during this incubation period.
	What if someone in my household develops symptoms or tests positive?	 The 14 day exclusion period will be extended until: 10 days have passed since any symptomatic member of the household first experienced symptoms, and any asymptomatic member of the household tested positive, and Symptoms have improved for everyone who had them, and Your household has been fever-free for 24 hours, without use of fever-reducing medications, and Your household has met any additional requirements imposed by the Department of Health or your doctor.
	Are travelers considered exposed?	 Anyone recommended to quarantine under applicable travel-restrictions may not visit the center for any reason (including drop-off/pick-up). Local guidance for travel-related restrictions does not apply to the whole household, however if symptoms do develop in the household, the household will be excluded.
