






# Keep Covid Out

My household is being excluded because someone has been...

## EXPOSED

 <p><b>Why?</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▶ Household spread is a leading cause of transmission.</li> <li>▶ Exposed individuals are instructed by public health authorities to quarantine.</li> </ul>
 <p><b>How long?</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▶ Your household will not be allowed in the center for at least 14 days.</li> </ul>
 <p><b>Can we come back sooner?</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▶ No. COVID-19 has a 14 day incubation. A doctor cannot clear an individual to return because the doctor cannot determine whether an exposed person will become positive during this incubation period.</li> </ul>
 <p><b>What if someone in my household develops symptoms or tests positive?</b></p>	<p><b>The 14 day exclusion period will be extended until:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▶ 10 days have passed since any symptomatic member of the household first experienced symptoms, and any asymptomatic member of the household tested positive, and...</li> <li>▶ Symptoms have improved for everyone who had them, and...</li> <li>▶ Your household has been fever-free for 24 hours, without use of fever-reducing medications, and...</li> <li>▶ Your household has met any additional requirements imposed by the Department of Health or your doctor.</li> </ul>
 <p><b>Are travelers considered exposed?</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▶ Anyone recommended to quarantine under applicable travel restrictions may not visit the center for any reason (including drop-off/pick-up).</li> <li>▶ Local guidance for travel-related restrictions does not apply to the whole household, however if symptoms do develop in the household, the household will be excluded.</li> </ul>
