My household is being excluded because someone has been...

EXPOSED

 <p>Why?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Household spread is a leading cause of transmission. ▶ Exposed individuals are instructed by public health authorities to quarantine.
 <p>How long?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Your household will not be allowed in the center for at least 10 days. ▶ During any period of exclusion, tuition continues to be due and payable.
 <p>Can we come back sooner?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ No. A doctor cannot clear an individual to return because the doctor cannot determine whether an exposed person will become positive during this incubation period.
 <p>What if we have been vaccinated or have had COVID-19 before?</p>	<p>You may have the option to return before the end of the exclusion period, depending on where you are in your period of immunity and whether you choose to share that information for consideration with your center.</p>
 <p>What if someone in my household develops symptoms or tests positive?</p>	<p>The exclusion period will be extended until:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ 10 days have passed since any symptomatic member of the household first experienced symptoms, and any asymptomatic member of the household tested positive, and... ▶ Symptoms have improved for everyone who had them, and... ▶ Your household has been fever-free for 24 hours, without use of fever-reducing medications, and... ▶ Your household has met any additional requirements imposed by the Department of Health or your doctor.
 <p>Are travelers considered exposed?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Anyone who is not fully vaccinated and has traveled internationally, or has traveled domestically and had been recommended to quarantine under applicable travel-restrictions may not visit the center for any reason (including drop-off/pick-up). ▶ Local guidance for travel-related restrictions does not apply to the whole household, however if symptoms do develop in the household, the household will be excluded.
