Health & Safety (COVID-19)

In accordance with recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), the San Antonio Museum of Art has adopted the following health and safety policies for the protection of our visitors, staff, and volunteers:

- The Museum strongly recommends that masks be worn by all visitors, volunteers and staff including guided and self-guided tour groups, while inside the Museum.
- 2. Masks are optional while outdoors, but strongly recommended in situations where physical distancing is not possible.
- 3. Visitors who feel unwell or have symptoms of COVID-19 should remain at home if possible.
- 4. Please practice standard preventive measures (e.g., wash hands, cover coughs, etc.).

General Museum Tour Policies

- 1. For PK-12 school groups, students **must** be always accompanied by a teacher or school-approved chaperone while on campus.
- 2. Please do not touch any works of art.
- 3. Coat check is available; large bags or backpacks (more than 11x15 inches) are not permitted.
- 4. Flash photography is not permitted.
- 5. Food, drink, and gum are not permitted in the galleries.
- 6. Only graphite pencils may be used in the galleries.
- 7. All visitors must comply with instructions from Museum staff.
- 8. Group size is limited to 60 students per one-hour time slot (subject to change).
