Edward Kelsey Moore is The New York Times best-selling author of "The Supremes Sing the Happy Heartache Blues" and "The Supremes at Earl's All-You-Can-Eat." He is a professional cellist who has performed with acclaimed orchestras including Chicago Sinfonietta, the Joffrey Ballet Orchestra and the Chicago Philharmonic.

His award-winning essays and short fiction have appeared in The New York Times and a number of literary magazines, including Ninth Letter, Indiana Review, African-American Review and Inkwell. Readers will enjoy the Indiana ties in Moore's work.
