Dear Parents of Little Oaks,

This year we are changing our strategy for our summer school age campers. There are several reasons we have decided to do this, first reason being increased enrollment at the center. We opened a second infant room to accommodate our growing families, which was the space your child(ren) use to occupy for the summer months. Second, with such a high enrollment in the summer program with a variety of ages, we decided to separate them into lower and upper elementary classes. We will be converting the Art Studio into a room for upper elementary children (ages 9-12) and lower elementary children (ages 5-8) will be in our existing Kindergarten Prep classroom.

This year the theme for summer is going to be focused around STEM. Every 2 weeks the theme will change, giving children and teachers more time to explore each topic in greater depth. We will be incorporating STEM into each theme. We are excited that Bright Horizon's Education Department has created a new curriculum for us to utilize for our older learners.

We have space for 12 to 14 children who are lower elementary aged children and space for 8 children who are considered upper elementary age. This summer we are unable to accommodate flex scheduling. All children enrolled in our Summer Camp Program will be contracted to the days of the week you sign up for the duration of the summer. Because of our increased enrollment over the past year, we are unable to accommodate special schedules.

Registrations will be due April 1, 2019. Families will be charged a one- time camp registration fee of \$75.00 for one child, and \$125.00 for a family fee.
