



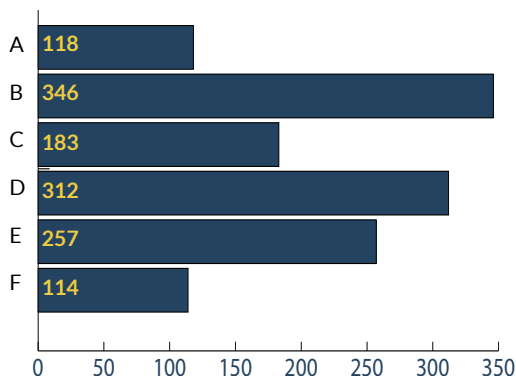

BUDGET PRIORITIES

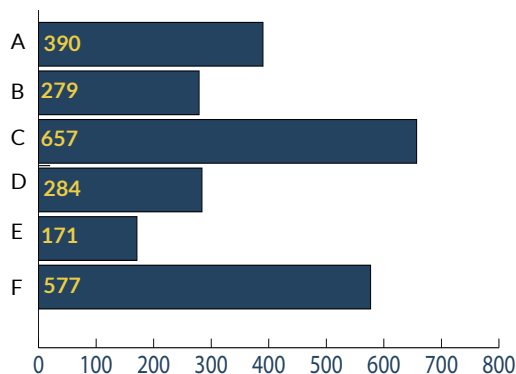
