

Traffic situations

26-31 January: Kronenburg intersection closed, traffic diverted via Zonnestein

During this week, amongst other work, the sides of the bridge decks will be finished, by installing specific elements and mesh windows. We will also adjust the infrastructure, ahead of the next traffic situations.





1 and 2 February: Beneluxbaan entirely closed between Uilenstede and Kronenburg

During this weekend, the new Beneluxbaan will be connected to the existing one, north of the petrol stations. We will also, at the Biesbosch intersection, construct temporary connections for the next traffic situations. Consequences:

- Between Friday evening 31 January 20.00 hours until Monday morning 3 February 5.00 hours, Beneluxbaan will be closed in its entirety, and in both directions, between Uilenstede and Kronenburg. Local traffic will be diverted around the location. Ongoing traffic will be diverted via Amstelveenseweg and Keizer Karelweg.
- From Friday 31 January 20.00 hours, one lane of Beneluxbaan will be closed (in both directions) between Kronenburg and Zonnestein.
- During this weekend, there will be no access to the petrol stations.
- From Friday evening 20.00 hours, bus 55 will run along a shortened route, up to Amstelveen's bus station and not up to Amsterdam South station. Tram 6 will run, in addition to tram 5.
- Nightbus N84 will be diverted via Van Nijenrodeweg - Amstelveenseweg - Keizer Karelweg - Laan van Walcheren - Rembrandtweg and vice versa.
- Traffic wardens at the Biesbosch intersection.


3-14 February: Saskia van Uylenburgweg closed between Beneluxbaan and Eleanor Rooseveltlaan

During these two weeks, Saskia van Uylenburgweg will be connected to the new roundabout and work will take place on the bridge decks. Traffic to and from the Kronenburg business parks will be diverted via Zonnestein. For the first time, ongoing traffic will use the lowered Kronenburg intersection. At street level, one lane will remain for local traffic.




15-16 February: various closures east of Kronenburg

During this weekend, the roundabout at the Saskia van Uylenburgweg side will be connected to the new Beneluxbaan. Work will also continue on the bridge decks. Between Saturday 15 February 1.00 hours and Monday 17 February 5.00 hours, the intersection at Kronenburg will be closed, Saskia van Uylenburgweg between Beneluxbaan and Eleanor Rooseveltlaan will still be closed, and there will only be one lane for ongoing traffic towards Amsterdam via the lowered Kronenburg intersection. As a consequence of this, there will be no access to the petrol station. After this weekend, this side of the roundabout will be ready for motorised traffic.




17-21 February: various closures west of Kronenburg

During this week, the roundabout at the Rembrandtweg side will be connected to the new Beneluxbaan. Therefore, Rembrandtweg will be closed between Beneluxbaan and Van Heuven Goedhartlaan, as well as the Beneluxbaan lane at street level. In addition, the Kronenburg intersection will be closed. Local traffic will be diverted via Zonnestein. All traffic on Beneluxbaan towards the south will use the lowered Kronenburg intersection. As a consequence of this, there will be no access to the petrol station.




22 February-9 March: Rembrandtweg closed between Beneluxbaan and Van Heuven Goedhartlaan

During these two weeks, we will concentrate on the finishing touches of the Kronenburg roundabout for motorised traffic, cyclists and pedestrians. We will, for example, connect Rembrandtweg to the roundabout and construct a new culvert underneath Rembrandtweg, to connect the ditches. Local traffic will be diverted via Zonnestein. On 9 March, the Kronenburg intersection will be fully reopened for all traffic, and the new Kronenburg stop will be in use for public transport customers. The (night)bus stop will also be moved to Kronenburg. The temporary Biesbosch stop and crossing will be closed on this date. Cyclists can use the intersections at Kronenburg and Onderuit. For pedestrians, there will be a temporary minibus between Zonnestein and the Kostverlorenhof shopping centre.



14 and 15 March: tram 5 replaced by bus 45, Zonnestein intersection closed


On Saturday 14 and Sunday 15 March, tram 5 will be replaced by bus 45. During this weekend, amongst other work, we will remove the Biesbosch stop and we will deconstruct the temporary Beneluxbaan at Kronenburg. At Zonnestein, work will take place on the bridge decks and elements will be hung up. Local traffic towards Kostverlorenhof will be diverted via Kronenburg.



4 and 5 April: Beneluxbaan entirely closed between Zonnestein and Oranjebaan


During this weekend, the new Beneluxbaan will be connected to the existing one, south of Zonnestein. Consequences:

- Between Friday 3 April 20.00 hours until Monday 6 April 5.00 hours, Beneluxbaan will be closed in both directions between Zonnestein and Oranjebaan. Local traffic will be diverted around the location.
- From Friday 3 April 20.00 hours, one lane of Beneluxbaan will be closed (in both directions) between Kronenburg and Zonnestein.
- From Friday evening 20.00 hours, bus 55 will run along a shortened route, up to Amstelveen's bus station and not up to Amsterdam South station. Tram 6 will run, in addition to tram 5.
- Nightbus N84 will be diverted via Zonnestein - Van Heuven Goedhartlaan and vice versa.




6-17 April: Straat van Messina closed between Beneluxbaan and Van Heuven Goedhartlaan

During these two weeks, Straat van Messina will be connected to the new roundabout and work will be done on the bridge decks. Local traffic to and from Kostverlorenhof will be diverted via Kronenburg. For the first time, ongoing traffic will use the lowered Zonnestein intersection. At street level, one lane will remain for local traffic.




18-20 April: various closures east of Zonnestein

During this weekend, the roundabout at the Straat van Messina side will be connected to the new Beneluxbaan. Work will also continue on the bridge decks. Between Saturday 18 April 1.00 hours and Monday 20 April 5.00 hours, the intersection at Zonnestein will be closed, Straat van Messina between Beneluxbaan and Eleanor Rooseveltlaan will still be closed, and there will only be one lane for ongoing traffic towards Amsterdam via the lowered Zonnestein and Kronenburg intersections. After this weekend, this side of the roundabout will be ready for motorised traffic.



20-24 April: various closures west of Zonnestein

During this week, the roundabout at the Zonnestein side will be connected to the new Beneluxbaan. Therefore, Zonnestein will be closed between Beneluxbaan and Van Heuven Goedhartlaan, and the Zonnestein intersection will also be closed. Local traffic will be diverted via Kronenburg.



25 April-4 May: Zonnestein closed between Beneluxbaan and Van Heuven Goedhartlaan

In this period, we will finalise the Zonnestein roundabout for motorised traffic, cyclists and pedestrians. We will connect Zonnestein to the roundabout and give the bridge decks their final lay-out. As a consequence of this, Zonnestein will remain closed between Beneluxbaan and Van Heuven Goedhartlaan, as well as one lane of Beneluxbaan. Local traffic will be diverted via Kronenburg. On 4 May, the Zonnestein intersection will be fully reopened for all traffic, and the new Zonnestein stop will be in use for public transport customers.

Finally, between 4 May and 23 June the temporary Beneluxbaan at Zonnestein will be deconstructed, the cycle lanes along Beneluxbaan will be restored, and ditches will be dug.
