Regards Traffic lay-out changes Sportlaan

Dear residents, business owners,

We expect to reopen the Sportlaan intersection on Saturday 25 July 2020. In order to do this, in June VITAL will start changing the traffic lay-out: connecting new roads to existing ones. With this letter, I would like to inform you about this work, how it may affect you and invite you to attend our online information evening.

Online information evening Thursday 28 May

As we are currently not able to organise regular meetings, we would like to invite you to our online information evening on Thursday 28 May between 19.00 and 20.00 hours. This will happen live via our Facebook page: <https://www.facebook.com/Amstelveenlijn/>. All you need is a Facebook account, which will enable you to visit our page. During this hour, you will be able to ask questions via the response option. The meeting can also be watched afterwards.

Traffic lay-out changes Sportlaan

Whilst VITAL currently is still finalising its building work, the changing of the traffic lay-out will begin in the weekend of 6 and 7 June. The Sportlaan intersection will be reopened for all road users on Saturday 25 July. Public transport users will be able to use the new Sportlaan stop from December 2020.

The reconstruction results in a number of changing traffic situations, and unfortunately lots of inconvenience for road users. Please check the attached leaflet for more information about the traffic changes.

Additional consequences

- The work will be done during regular hours, Monday to Friday between 7.00 and 19.00 hours – except for the following dates, when work also takes place during the night:

- Friday 5 up to and including Monday 8 June

- Friday 3 up to and including Monday 6 July

- The work will cause inconvenience in terms of noise, particularly during / because of the transport of prefab components, tarmac grinding, compressing of soil and road foundations, tarmacking and a large amount of work traffic.

- There will be inconvenience for road users because of the large number of changing traffic situations and possibly because of work traffic. VITAL will deploy traffic wardens where necessary.

- No specific inconvenience is expected in terms of dust and dirt. If there were to be inconvenience, VITAL will take measures to keep the roads clean.

- Emergency services will always have free passage.
