Vision:

- 1.) Hold in Tension Pastoral Renewal and Evangelizing Outreach
 - Consider what we are inviting people to experience
- 2.) Understand That Renewal is An Inside Job
 - Conversion (initial or ongoing) of self, staff, leadership...good soil for systemic renewal
- 3.) Vision Everything Through Lens of Evangelization
 - It's the very mission of the Church, not just another ministry of the parish
- 4.) Approach Evangelization as Holistically as the Parish System Will Allow
 - Accept limitations where necessary and channel energy toward areas with potential
- 5.) Lead with Jesus Christ
 - And then also appropriately attend to Catholic and Church
- 6.) See Your Parish Through Fresh Eyes
 - Seek out valuable (honest) input from new parishioners and visitors
- 7.) Experience Other Churches
 - Field trips and conversations can yield insights and spark ideas
- 8.) Radical Surrender to the Holy Spirit
 - A parish cannot fear failure (or success) and be pentecostal
- 9.) Invest in People More than Building
 - Why is it ok to take on debt for brick-and-mortar but not for ministry?
- 10.) Imagine Possibilities from a Blue-Sky Perspective
 - Don't let limitations hinder initial visioning...lest your dreams be timid

Operational:

- 11.) Stay the Course... As Long As the Course is Sound
 - Don't swerve or flail about
- 12.) Market Effectively and Broadly
 - Out of the Catholic bubble and into the world!
- 13.) Empower the Gifts of the Holy Spirit (in your People) for the Community
 - Already present is the means to broaden (and enhance) our pastoral bandwidth
- 14.) Go After Low-Hanging Fruit
 - Early! Sacraments! Parents!
- 15.) Recognize the Disproportionate Importance and Potential of the Sunday Experience
 - Its impact is greater than the other days combined
- 16.) Pay Attention to the Vibe
 - The normal, the natural, the human (ie. hospitality) matter *greatly*
- 17.) Allow for Quick Wins in the Midst of Planning
 - Intentionality allows for agility that reveals life, grace and movement
- 18.) Understand Where People Are...And Meet Them *There*
 - Empathize...then evangelize
- 19.) Grow a Culture of All-Hands-on-Deck for Sharing Faith and Inviting
 - Embrace of baptismal identity, missionary discipleship lifestyle
- 20.) Remember the Power of (Intercessory) Prayer
 - Parish-wide campaign invoking the power of the Holy Spirit
