Greg Iles is the \#1 New York Times best-selling author of 17 novels, including the "Natchez Burning" series. Join Greg as he talks about his newest novel, "Cemetery Road," an electrifying tale of friendship, betrayal and shattering secrets that threaten to destroy a small Mississippi town.

Greg Iles was born in Germany in 1960, where his father ran the U.S. Embassy Medical Clinic during the height of the Cold War. Iles spent his youth in Natchez, Mississippi, and graduated from the University of Mississippi in 1983. Iles wrote his first novel in 1993, a thriller about Nazi war criminal Rudolf Hess, which became the first of 12 New York Times best-sellers. His novels have been made into films, translated into more than 20 languages and published in more than 35 countries worldwide.
