Last but not least students will build a garbage truck using various different construction paper shapes.

Nocturnal Animals will be our focus for the third week of October. Students will learn and sort which animals are nocturnal vs. non-nocturnal. Friends will match shaped owls to their corresponding shaped tree. We will also search through a "cave" (tent) to find the missing bat letters. To bring everything together students will create a night seene using paint, star stickers, moons and animal cut outs.

Time to blast off to outer space this week! Friends will create their own rocket ships using magnet tiles. Students will match corresponding lettered moons to matching lettered stars. Look out for aliens! Friends will use a paper plate and green tissue paper to create an alien. Before we fly back home to earth, students will create their own model of the 9 planets using play dough.

The last week of October is all about Halloween! Friends will trace the letter of week in goblin slime. We will get messy while pulling the insides out of a pumpkin and sorting the seeds. Children will use green tissue paper and contact paper to construct a Frankenstein face. To end the Halloween theme friends will use their fine motors to count and pull out spiders from a spider's web.
