
Incredible Imaginations

We are so excited to be gaining new friends and families to our classroom! We would like to welcome Arie, Natsumi, Lily, Audrey and Samuel to the *Orange Room!*

During the first week of August students will be learning about the *Circus* and the *Carnival*. This includes learning about and exploring cotton candy, clowns, carnival games, circus tents and popcorn. During science, teacher will make popcorn bucket play dough mats with different numbers on them for students to use yellow play dough to add the corresponding amount of *popcorn* to the buckets. During literacy, students will play circus bingo in small groups. During art, students will use craft sticks, animal crackers, paper, scissors, and glue to create *circus tents*.

During the second week students will be learning abut the *Wild West*. Topics include cowboys/cowgirls, wagons, horses, and *cacti*. During literacy, students will help the cowboy and horse find their way to the town by completing the missing letters of the alphabet. During math, students will I use *lassos* (made from yarn) to make numbers. During art, students will make a wanted poster.







During the third week of August, students will be learning about *Inventions* and *Robots*. This includes learning about different types of inventions, parts of a robot, magnets and *nuts* and *bolts*. During math, students will take turns rolling a dice and adding the corresponding pieces to build a robot. During literacy, students will complete alphabet robot puzzles by putting them in alphabetical order. During art, students will use *screws*, tubes bolts, and *nuts* to paint with and explore different shapes as they paint.

During the last week of the month, we will be learning about *Dinosaurs*. Topics include Tyrannosaurs Rex, Stegosaurus, Brachiosaurs, and *fossils*. During literacy students will help the dinosaurs eat the letter of the week. During math students will add spikes to the stegosaurs' back. During art, students will use their handprint to make a dinosaur. We hope you enjoy our fun activities!
