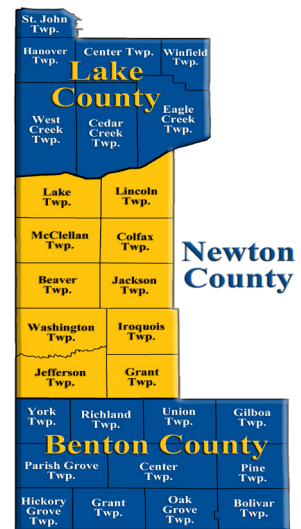
Niemeyer is a member of the Senate Committees on Environmental Affairs, Homeland Security and Transportation, Local Government, and Veterans Affairs and the Military.

Outside the Senate, Niemeyer is the owner and operator of Lowell Livestock Auction, the managing broker of Niemeyer Realty and the auctioneer and owner of Niemeyer Auction Service.

Niemeyer's civic involvement goes beyond his service in the General Assembly. He is a former Township Trustee and Assessor for West Creek Township, Lake County Councilman from the 7th District, Chair of the Lake County Solid Waste Board, and member of the Lake County Planning Commission and Drainage Board Advisory Committee. He is also a former member of the Tri-Creek Ambulance Service Agency. Niemeyer is a member of St. John United Church of Christ.
