ENCOMPASS UPDATE—Melissa Todd, CFA Client Liaison

- Following an official signature, the Encompass Care Advantage program will launch in January 2019.
- "Lunch & Learn" sessions are currently scheduled and will cover a variety of topics; two upcoming topics will be 'Educational Loan Repayment' and 'Saving for College'.
- Prior to launch, registration sessions will be made available for the Encompass program.

EXPANSION PROJECT UPDATE—Melissa Todd, CFA Client Liaison

- The construction of Building A is progressing as planned and projected to be turned over end of Q1. At this time, we cannot announce an official opening date.
- Due to construction constraints and budget, the proposed "Bee Wall" will no longer contain a live colony. It will still be an interactive wall where the children will learn about bees and how bees impact their world.
- The JCCC Memory Wall is still in creation. The vendor is Sketch Effects. Thank you to current and previous families for providing memories and guotes for the wall.

SOFT REMINDERS—Rosalind Johnson, Executive Director

- Due to space constraints at JCCC, we ask that all parents utilize the Mobile Work Stations provided by Chick-fil-A and not the atriums of JCCC. We welcome and encourage you to visit your child's classroom at any point during the day however extended visits to complete work are no longer an option.
- We have seen an increase in cell phone usage during drop off and pick up and would like to remind all parents
 of our "Be Present" policy regarding cell phones. Please refrain from using your cell phone during drop off and
 pick up. Carpool escorts have been advised to bypass parents on the phone in the carpool lane until they are
 ready to participate in the service and receive their children.
- We would like to remind all of our parents about a few key policies at JCCC:
 - If you have an infant and older child enrolled at JCCC, please drop the older child off first and then the
 infant. Older children may not sit outside the classroom unattended while the infant is being dropped
 off.
 - o It is unlawful to leave children in a vehicle unattended. Leaving a child in a vehicle with no one present may result in fines for the childcare center and additional ramifications for parents.
 - Leaving your vehicle running during drop off and pick up is no longer an accepted practice on the JCCC campus. If you need to warm up or cool down your vehicle due to weather, please do so prior to coming to the JCCC campus.
 - We thank you all for your continued cooperation in keeping the children at JCCC safe, secure and healthy.

JCCC ORGANIZATION UPDATE—Rosalind Johnson, Executive Director

- As we look forward to the opening of Building A, we would like to lay out our new organizational structure in more detail.
- We will move from a "center wide" system to a "house" system; each building will, in a sense, operate as its own house under the JCCC umbrella.
- Each building will have its own core Administrative team and the following things will be specific to each building:
 - Families will be in one building, unless otherwise requested
 - o Parent Representative and Family Partnership Meetings
 - Center Events
 - Parent Conferences
 - Schedules
- The names of the buildings will also change:
 - o Building A ⇒ The Treehouse
 - o Building B ⇒ Sierra; (the room names will also change in this building)
 - Building C ⇒ The Woodlands
