What's been happening?

It has been a long hard 15 months for many, the community Centre had to close along with everything else in the country back in March 2020. However once government guidance was released, we got to work putting measures in place to make the Centre covid secure. This meant that support groups could continue for the majority of the time in line with government advice and, in between local and national lockdowns, other activities could also return to the Centre.

We have been lucky enough to be awarded several grants over the last year which has helped fund continued running of the Centre and other specific activities.

We received an "Emergency Covid Fund" grant from the National Lottery Community Fund. This grant enabled us to cover operational costs to ensure we would be in a financial position to reopen at full capacity as and when allowed.

We were also lucky enough to be awarded grants from Wiltshire and Swindon Sport Partnership (WASP) as well as Green Square which will help fund our afternoon tea sessions going forward. They resumed on 22nd June 2021 and takes place every Tuesday 1:30-3:30. Each session will feature 30mins of light exercise to get people moving again after long stints of isolation.

One final grant we received meant we were able to fund online Mindfulness courses. These courses were run by Susie Stead who is trained, and competency tested, by the Oxford Mindfulness Centre. Having a grant for this meant people could do a taster session for free and we were then able to subside costs to enable those who may otherwise be unable to afford a full course to take part during a time where mindfulness was needed most by lots of people. We are now planning another course aimed more specifically towards parents so watch this space for a start date in September.

We are finally at a point where the Centre is looking alive again. Children's activities resumed in April closely followed by adult sessions in May and we are now accepting bookings for social events from 19th July onwards.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank our regular customers for their continued support during this time and express how excited we are to welcome the community back to our building for future events.

Our Facilities

Main Hall



A light and spacious hall. Suitable for community groups, clubs, and larger gatherings such as family parties, presentations and meetings - it includes a serving hatch to the kitchen. Can be used together with garden room for larger numbers of people. Max Capacity – 60 people or 120 when hired with the Garden room

Garden Room



A delightful, spacious room with an outlook and access to the small walled garden. Ideal for meetings and small gatherings - it has it's own access door and the use of a disabled W/C. We offer a reduced rate for this room when booking with the main hall. Max Capacity - 25

Meeting Room



This is a meeting space (30 ft x 12 ft) completely separate from the main hall in a quieter area of the building. It is ideal for both business meetings and community bookings or as a break-out area. Max Capacity -20

Christ Church



The church at Christ Church is situated at the top of the hill on Cricklade Street and can be seen for miles from several locations around the town. Ideal for large meetings, concerts, and other events. Max Capacity – 300 People

St Mary's



Situated close to the main centre on Commonweal Road, St Mary's church hall is a spacious facility with access to a small kitchenette. Ideal for local resident and community meetings. Max Capacity – 70 people

Capacities listed are the maximum for each room but will vary depending on the layout required and the activity/event taking place.
