Explanatory notes on the provisional programme of the 7<sup>th</sup> ICLARS Conference at Notre Dame University, USA, 21-23 October 2024

Some explanatory notes on the provisional programme of the conference and the distribution of parallel sessions:

- 1. **Dates and times of parallel sessions**. In the distribution of panels in parallel sessions we have tried our best to accommodate all the requests we have received. The precise time of each session might experience minor adjustments at a later stage, but the dates assigned to each session are not supposed to be modified.
- 2. **Unforeseen difficulties**. If some persons have difficulties to participate in their respective sessions in the assigned dates and times, please let us know at your earliest convenience writing to this email address: Tonya Gage, <u>tonya.gage@law.byu.edu</u>.
- 3. Incorrect or incomplete information. Please, use the same email address above if you find some incorrect or incomplete information in the distribution of parallel sessions. In some panels there is mention of the precise topic of each presentation, while in others there is only the general title of the panel. The former occurs in the panels we have formed out of the proposals of individual papers we received, and the latter occurs when the panel was proposed as such by its organizer. Panel organizers should not feel obliged to provide precise topics for each presentation in their sessions, but they can do so.
- 4. **Chairs of panels**. In the panels formed out of the proposals of individual papers received, we assume that the first person in the list will act as chair of the panel. If that person prefers not to assume that role, please let us know as soon as possible, so that we can find a replacement.
- 5. Language of sessions. Plenary sessions will be in English, and simultaneous interpretation is not foreseen. We assume that panels in parallel sessions will be in English, except when we have received a different information. Currently we have some panels in Spanish, as indicated in the provisional programme. If the organizers of some other panels have in mind a language other than English, please let us know as soon as possible, so that we can include that important information in the programme.
