

We are so excited to be in March. Spring is finally here and we are going to be busy this month, learning about our monthly topic, Spring is in the Air.

The first week we will talk about Dr. Seuss's Birthday. The kiddos will read some of Dr. Seuss books and they will taste test green food. They will also spell out the words, Hop on Pop, using popcorn and glue.

The second week, kiddos will be learning about wetlands/ponds. We will learn about animals and plants like ducks, frogs, lilies and crocodiles. The kids will make water lilies out of construction paper and paper plates. Then, we will read about different kind of flowers and discuss each child's favorite thing about flowers. We will also learn the life cycle of a frog and learn why and how ducks feathers stay dry.

The following week, we will be talking about St. Patrick's Day. The kids will spell out letters using lucky charms cereal and they will conduct a rainbow science experiment using skittles candy and water. Children will also make the Irish flag using construction paper.

The last week of March, the students will learn about spring. We will discuss what we see and feel in spring time such as flowers blooming, rain, rainbows, clouds, and wind. The kids will make their own pinwheel and practice cutting with scissors, and then they will learn the names of different parts of the flower.
