We will be focusing on the colors in the rainbow, flowers and bugs. Friends will be sorting parts of a flower that include leaves, stems and petals and creating their own flowers. Friends will be using their artistic skills to create their own birds using a paper plate, shredded colored paper and feathers.

"What's the weather? What's the weather like today? Is it sunny, is it rainy, or cloudy out today?" Our last week of March friends will learn all about the weather and seasons. Together as a class we will do a science experiment to understand what clouds do. We will have a jar filled with water and friends will take turns adding shaving cream to the top of the jar. After adding shaving cream friends will each receive a turn to drop in food coloring and we will see what happens to the water in the clouds! After our science experiment friends will learn about the water cycle and how it happens. Friends will have the opportunity to sequence the water cycle felt pictures in order after discussing it in our book "The Water Cycle at Work" by Rebecca Olien.
