Co-branding

Minimum size of logo

The size of the logo should be in the same proportion as the rest of the logos. For example, measuring width: 27 mm

The example shown is the size as it would appear on a magazine page measuring 210 mm wide

When writing '3daysofdesign' in text, the name should always appear as one word using lower-case letters. Written without spaces or hyphens.
