Regulations:

1. The competition will be conducted according to the rules of SKDUN and WTKA on May 21, 2022. The date of birth determines the age category! It is allowed to start competitors in two age categories (apart from juniors' start in seniors kumite). It is forbidden to start in two weight categories within one age category!

2. KATA individual and team, are described in Annex 1. In kategories age 9 and younger and 10-11 age can do any kata, different in each round / minimum two alternating. In these categories kata are performed parallel to each other. Allowed kata: Shito, Wado, Goju, Shotokan, Shorin, Kyokushin.

KATA Kobudo: Ryukyu Kobudo, Matayoshi Kobudo, Yamani Ryu. Weapons: Bo, Eku/Oar, Sai, Tonfa, Kama, Nunchaku.

3. KUMTE fight time; Kumite WTKA and SKDUN time of children's fights 60sek, cadets 90sek, juniors, adolescents and adults 120sek.

4. Repechage and two-third places for WKF, categories SKDUN and WTKA without repechage.

5. It is possible for a competitor to start in more than one age category.

Ochraniacze:

1. In SKDUN categories white thin mitts, mouth guard and suspensory (male).

2.Kumite WTKA, mitts like WKF blue and red, foot and shin protectors, mouth guard.

Protesty:

In writing to the Chief Judge after paying the bid security 450 zł / 100 euro.





Additional provisions:

1. Signing and sending the application form constitutes the applicant's definitive obligation to take part in the competition.

2. The exhibition and sale of folders, advertising materials, leaflets and letters as well as all valuables may only take place with the consent of the organizer.

3. Each participant of the competition is obliged to observe discipline and order and bears full responsibility for any damage caused on the premises of the facility.

4. The organizer is not responsible for lost items

5. In matters not covered by these Regulations, the provisions of the Regulations regarding the organization and holding of competitions shall apply SKDUN, WTKA and PUK or provisions of the Civil Code.

6. The list of judges will be established by the chairman of the jury in agreement with the organizer.

7. Any disputes regarding the course of the competition may be reported to the Organizer's address during the competition.

8. Only contestants and coaches may stay at the boards. Fans in the stands without the right to enter the main hall.9. Competitors may take part in more than one age competition.

10. The deadline for free removal of a competitor expires 3 days before the start of the competition. The deletion of a competitor should be reported by e-mail to the following address: skdun@ronin.pl. Deleting a competitor after the above-mentioned date is associated with the full payment of the entry fee. Adding a competitor / change of category after the deadline for applications (up to 3 days before the start of the competition) involves the payment of an additional fee in the amount of twice the starting fee in a given competition.

11. The organizer has the right to combine individual categories if a given category does not have at least 3 competitors.

COVID-19 related regulations:

Only contestants and coaches may stay in the Sports Hall, maintaining safety measures related to the restrictions related to the pandemic. All competitors must be under the supervision of coaches. The competition will be played without the participation of the public (parents of children). Obligation to cover your mouth and nose outside the fighting zone (tatami). Failure to comply with any sanitary rules may result in the disqualification of the competitor (club) from participation in the competition.

Responsibility:

Responsible for damages caused during the competition is the person - club, who caused it.
