Johnson County Public Library is more than buildings that house books...they are spaces – both physical and online – where anyone in our community is welcome to engage in learning, strengthen their family and attend cultural offerings. Libraries are a vital part of American society and a valuable community resource. They exemplify our county's aspiration to innovate and improve. By providing access to information libraries are assisting residents in expanding their horizons and realizing their dreams. Libraries are encouraging a new generation of readers, empowering entrepreneurs, preparing job seekers and engaging seniors.

Philanthropy has provided programming and collection support at Johnson County Public Library through generous donations from library patrons and residents of Johnson County since the public library was formed.

The Foundation's fundraising efforts are used to pilot new programs and expand the proven, high impact programs that JCPL already offers to early learners, school-aged students, teens, adults and seniors.

Ongoing support for these programs provides opportunities for our librarians to make a greater impact in our community. Currently donated funds account for 53% of funding of all programs and events at the Johnson County Public Library.

Why JCPL Matters

The Foundation bolsters several focus areas for the Library by raising private funds for innovative, multi-generational and cultural programs:

- 1. Invest in Young Minds** - by building confident caregivers, creating a culture of literacy and inspiring innovative experiences.
- 2. Engage and Strengthen the Community** - by bridging the opportunity gap, developing cultural understanding and becoming a community catalyst to make a difference in the lives of Johnson County residents.
- 3. Transform Lives by** - championing lifelong learning, engaging the community and delighting customers.

Library programs supported by the Johnson County Public Library Foundation are changing lives, especially for our children and seniors.

Our Summer Learning Program provided 65 programs to encourage children to build their STEAM skills (science, technology, engineering, arts and math). The Library is partnering with all the school systems in our Library district to provide online resource access accounts for every student.

Seniors' lives are enriched by attending engaging book clubs, art activities, lively discussions at community programs and simply a chance to connect with their community by visiting the Library often. Seniors enjoy socialization when they connect with our caring staff and participate in Library events.
