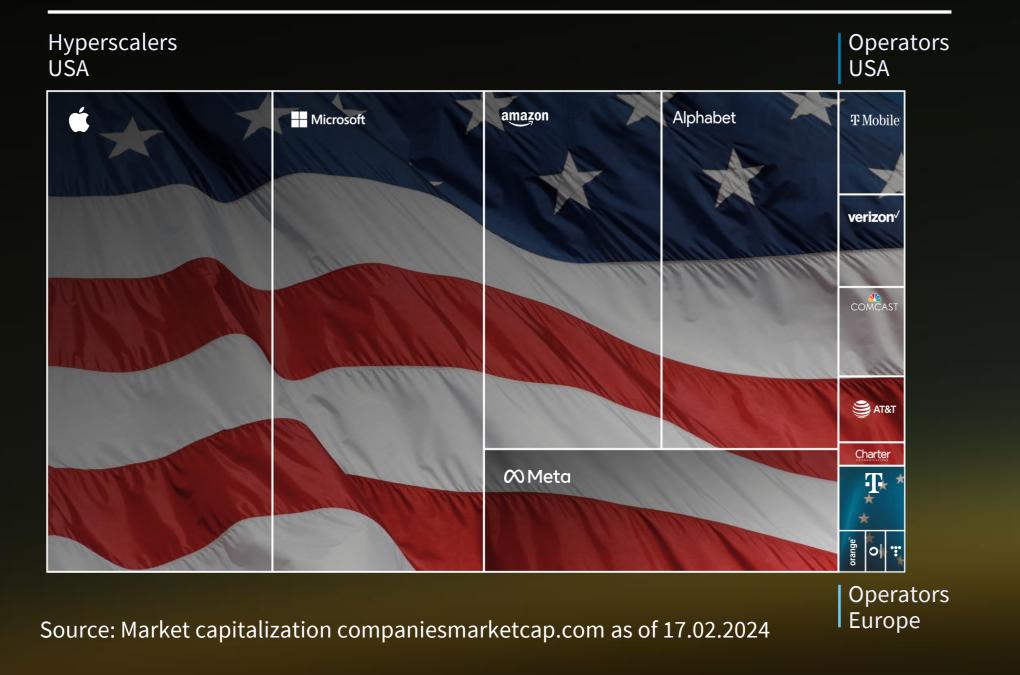

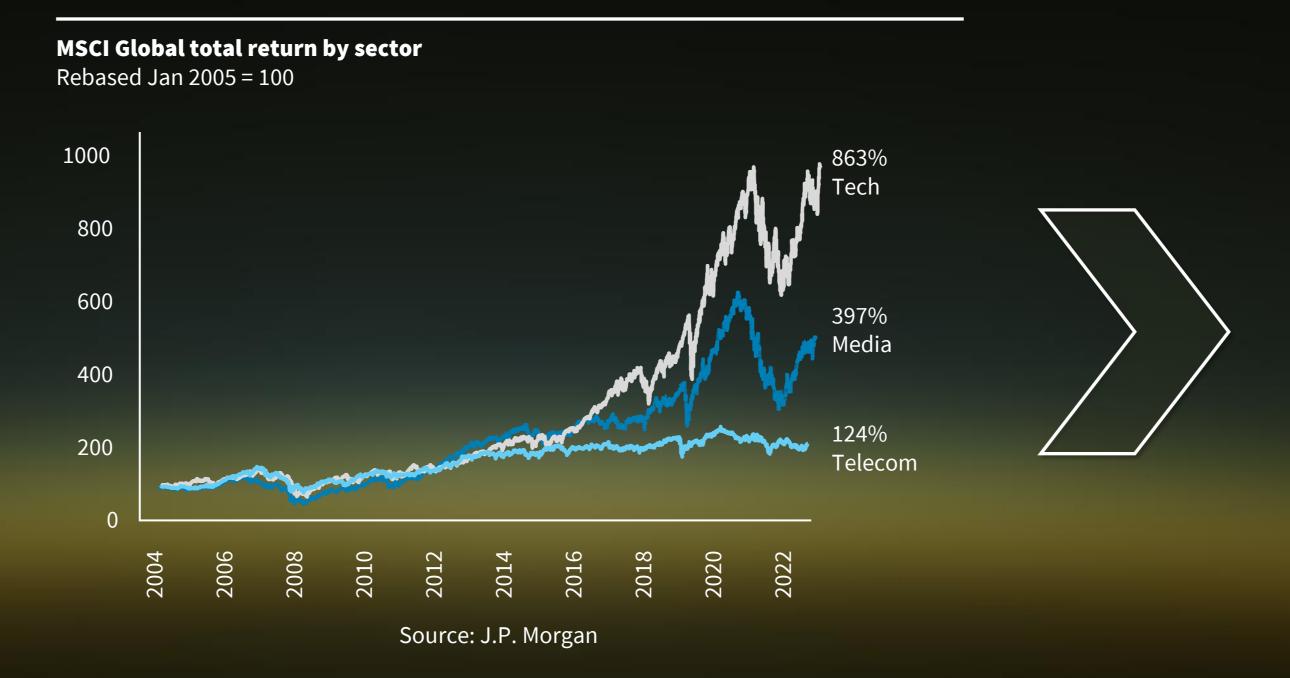

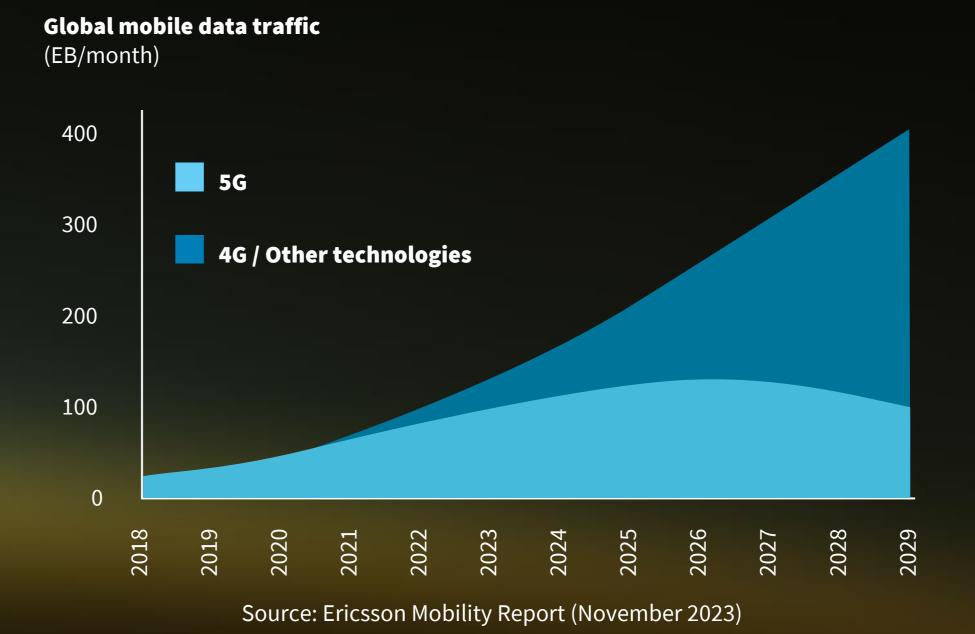
Hyperscalers vs. Mobile Operators

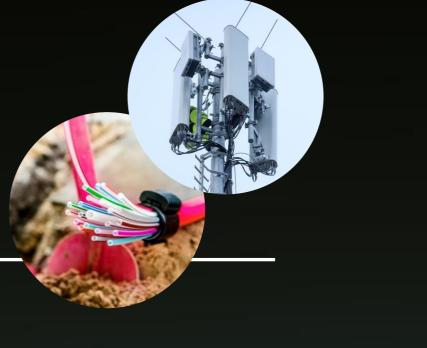
