



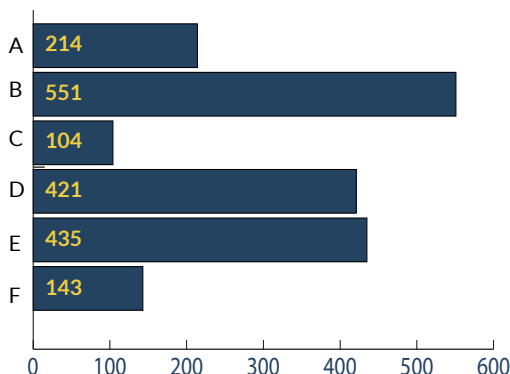

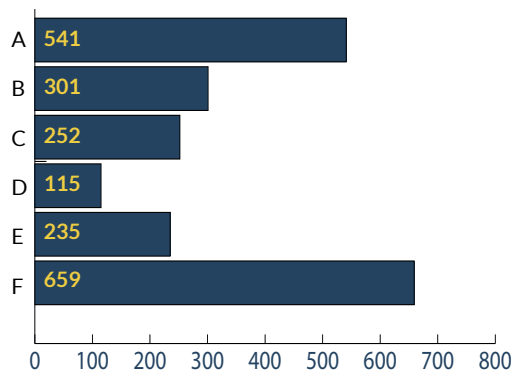

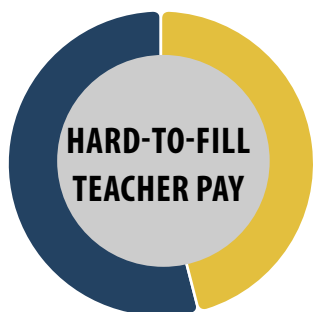
2. Which of the following changes would you support to increase road funding? (You may select more than one option.)

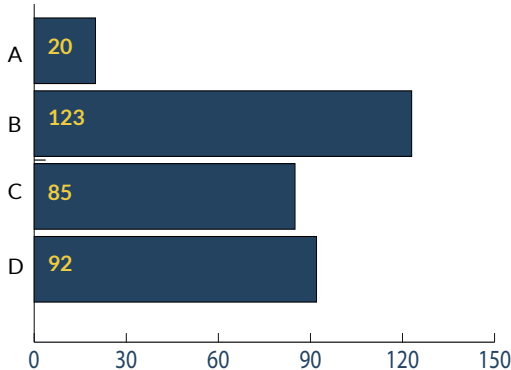

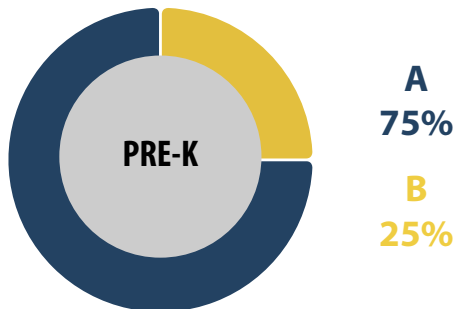
6. Which of the following do you think is more important?

EDUCATION PRIORITIES

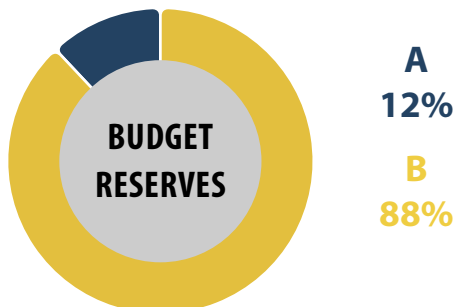
- A. Increasing funding for preschool programs

- D. None of these need a funding increase



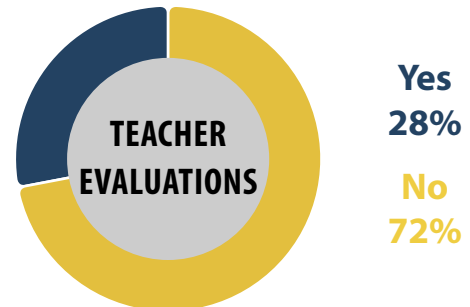

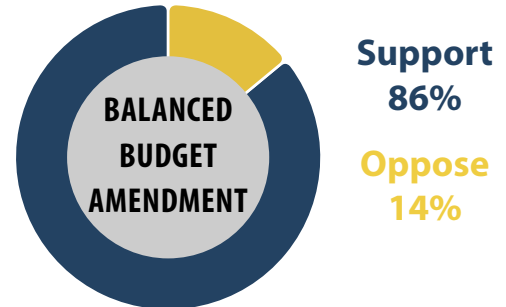

9. Should student scores from Indiana's statewide test be used as part of teachers' job performance evaluations?



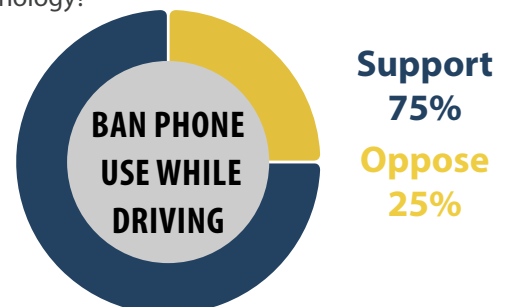
10. Do you support or oppose amending the Indiana Constitution to require the General Assembly to pass a balanced budget?
