Katy Perry Joins Special Guest Line-Up for

Celebrate LA!: LA Phil 100 at the Bowl
Sunday, September 30, 2018
7:00PM

Los Angeles, CA (August 13 2018) – The Los Angeles Philharmonic announced today that global superstar **Katy Perry** will join the line-up of special guest artists for **Celebrate LA!: LA**

Phil 100 at the Bowl, a free concert at the Hollywood Bowl on Sunday, September 30, 2018, at 7PM. Perry will join Gustavo Dudamel and the Los Angeles Philharmonic to perform a short set of top hits from her illustrious career. Previously announced special guests include Herbie Hancock, Kali Uchis, and YOLA (Youth Orchestra Los Angeles).

Tickets for **LA Phil 100 at the Bowl** will be available via online sweepstakes at laphil.com/celebratela. Online sweepstakes registration begins on August 20 and closes on September 2. The selection process is randomized, and the order of entry has no effect on the chances of winning. Entry limited to adults 18 and older. Void where prohibited. Other limitations may apply. Successful applicants will be notified via email in early September with details of how to claim their tickets, and within what time frame. Tickets not claimed during the allotted time frame will be forfeited. Tickets are completely free and not subject to any fees. Each winner will be limited to two tickets (per household). Tickets can only be utilized by the winner and not resold, forwarded, exchanged, or transferred. Standard parking, Park and Ride, and shuttle prices will be in effect for this concert.

More About Katy Perry:

Katy made her Capitol Records debut with 2008's *One of the Boys* after signing to the label in 2007. She cemented her status as a global superstar with the follow-up album, *Teenage Dream* (2010), which made her the only female artist (tied with Michael Jackson) to have five No. 1 singles from one album on the *Billboard* Hot 100 chart ("California Gurls," "Teenage Dream," "Firework," "E.T.," and "Last Friday Night"). *PRISM*, her 2013 album, debuted at No. 1 on iTunes in 100 countries and has sold more than 12.5 million adjusted albums worldwide. With the singles "Roar," "Firework," and "Dark Horse" each surpassing the 10-million threshold, including song sales and streams, Katy is the only artist to earn three RIAA Digital Single Diamond Awards. Katy Perry's fourth studio album, *WITNESS*, debuted in June 2017 at No. 1 on the *Billboard* Top 200 and No. 1 on iTunes in 46 countries. The lead single, "Chained to the Rhythm," set the record for the biggest first-day Spotify streams by a female artist and is now certified Platinum, with over one billion streams worldwide. Views on the accompanying video made her the most viewed female artist on VEVO. Follow-up singles, "Bon Appetit" (whose music video was Katy's fastest viewed music video of all time, with 14.2 million views in the first 24 hours) is certified Gold, and "Swish Swish" is now certified Platinum.

In her 10 years with Capitol, she has racked up a cumulative 18+ billion streams alongside worldwide sales of more than 40+ million adjusted albums and 125+ million tracks. Katy's 2015 Super Bowl performance is the highest rated in the event's history. She is the most followed person globally on Twitter and the first to surpass 100 million followers.

More about Celebrate LA!, September 30, 2018:

The concert **LA Phil 100 at the Bowl** is the culminating event of a day-long celebration called **Celebrate LA: LA Phil 100 x CicLAvia**, a massive, free, eight-mile street festival connecting Walt Disney Concert Hall with the Hollywood Bowl, presented in partnership with CicLAvia and Community Arts Resources (CARS). LA Phil 100 x CicLAvia begins at 9AM and features approximately 1800 performers – musicians, dancers, and visual artists, the vast majority of whom are from L.A. – with live shows and dancing programmed on six major hub stages, as well as art installations, food trucks, screen printing, and kid-friendly activities intersecting throughout. The entire eight-mile route will be transformed into an auto-free zone, where all are welcome to walk, run, skate, scoot, bike, and wander. It has no starting or ending point, and participants can join in anywhere they like, using any form of non-motorized transportation. All ages are encouraged to attend.

LA Phil 100:

In its Centennial year (September 2018 through October 2019), the LA Phil is inviting people from Los Angeles and around the world to join them in envisioning a future that music can help create. Major initiatives include presenting the orchestra's **most ambitious artistic season to date**, featuring over 50 commissioned works and the LA Phil's largest roster of artistic collaborations; investing in the future of young people by creating a **permanent YOLA center**, The Judith and Thomas L. Beckmen YOLA Center @ Inglewood, designed by **Frank Gehry**; establishing the **LA Phil Resident Fellows Program**, which will provide musicians representing or serving historically underrepresented populations opportunities for professional advancement; welcoming all of Los Angeles to **Celebrate LA! LA Phil 100 x CicLAvia**, a **free, massive, street festival** featuring performances by hundreds of musicians, dancers and visual artists, stretching from Grand Avenue in front of Walt Disney Concert Hall all the way to the Hollywood Bowl, and concluding with **LA Phil 100 at the Bowl**, a **free concert at the Hollywood Bowl**; the **"100 for the 100th: Be Our Guest" free ticket initiative**, which will invite thousands of new listeners into Walt Disney Concert Hall; and a **\$500 Million Centennial Campaign** to fund the future.

The Los Angeles Philharmonic Association, under the vibrant leadership of Music & Artistic Director Gustavo Dudamel, presents an inspiring array of music from all genres – orchestral, chamber and Baroque music, organ and celebrity recitals, new music, jazz, world music and pop – at two of L.A.'s iconic venues, Walt Disney Concert Hall (laphil.com) and the Hollywood Bowl (hollywoodbowl.com). The LA Phil's season at Walt Disney Concert Hall extends from September through May and throughout the summer at the Hollywood Bowl. With the preeminent Los Angeles Philharmonic at the foundation of its offerings, the LA Phil aims to enrich and transform lives through music, with a robust mix of artistic, education and community programs.
