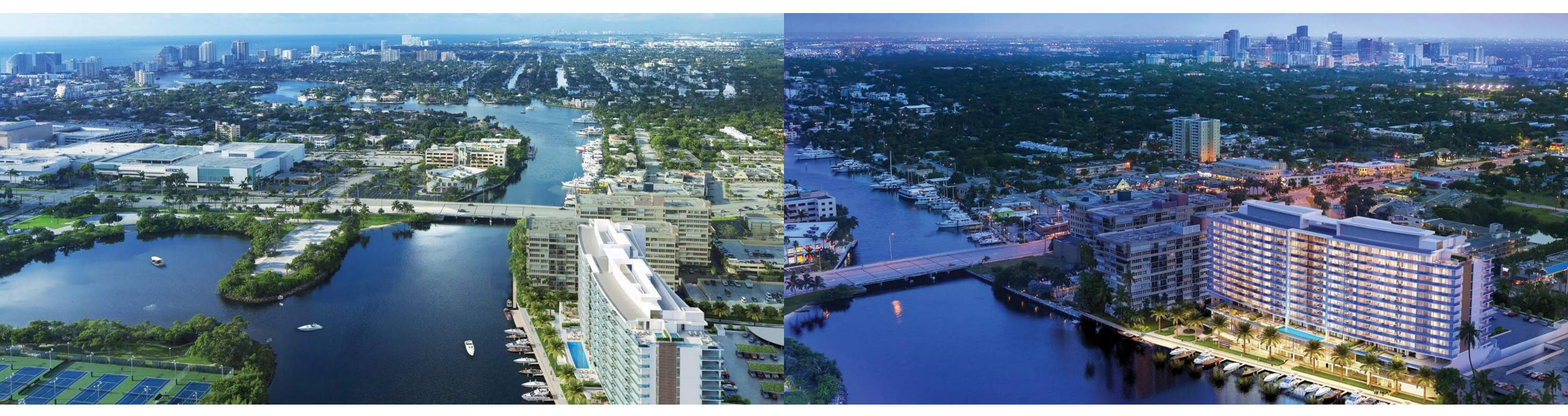

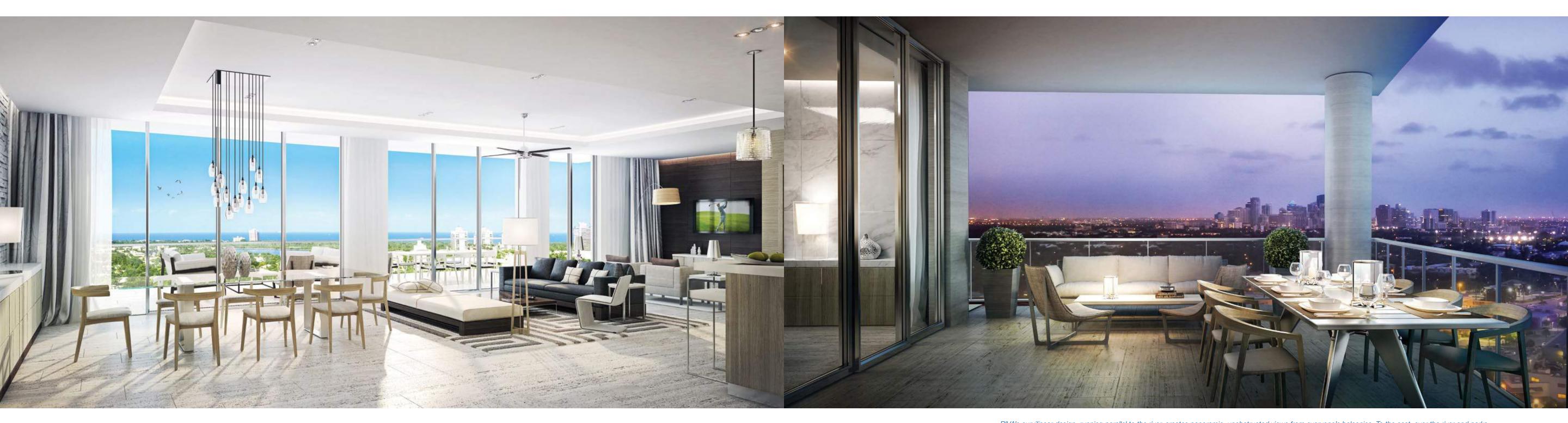
RIVA is at the heart of the intown neighborhood that is attracting more and more 5-star brands with a combination of city convenience and waterfront tranquility.



Set back off the main street, down a long palm-lined drive that leads right to the water, RIVA sits on its own 400 feet of riverfront park, with an owners' promenade and dock.

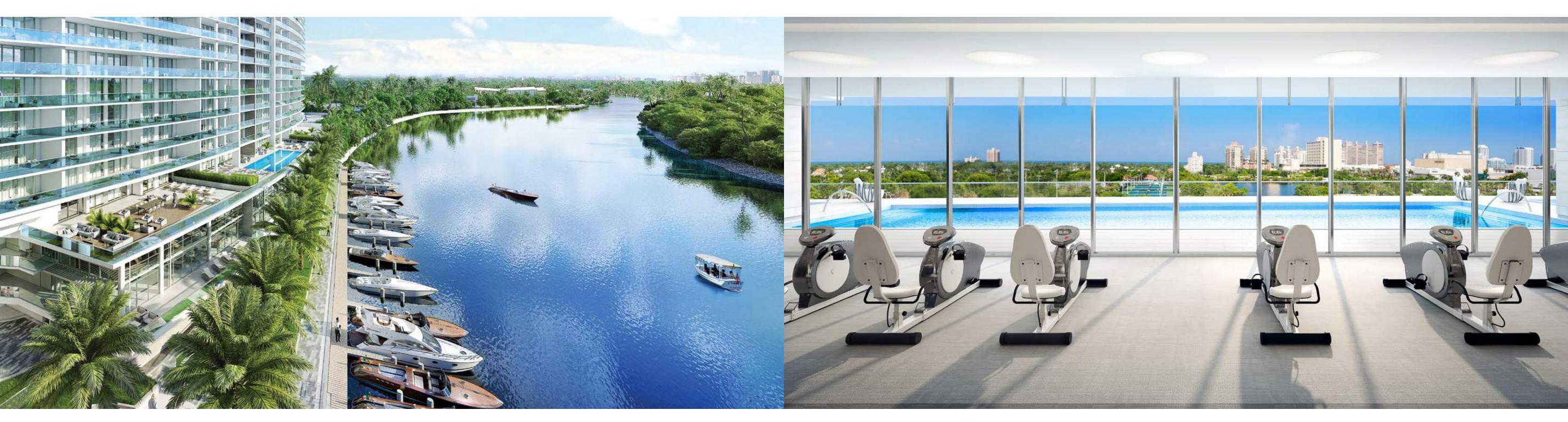
The riverfront lobby takes you from the covered arrival court directly out to the water. Check with the concierge, stop for an espresso in the café, drop off your paddleboard at the watersports center, or even take your boat out from your own slip. Every RIVA resident enjoys a waterfront lifestyle, at home.

RIVA's curvilinear design, running parallel to the river, creates panoramic, unobstructed views from everyone's balconies. To the east, over the river and parks, lies the blue horizon of the Atlantic Ocean. To the west are the endless sunset skies that turn to a curtain of twinkling city lights as night falls.

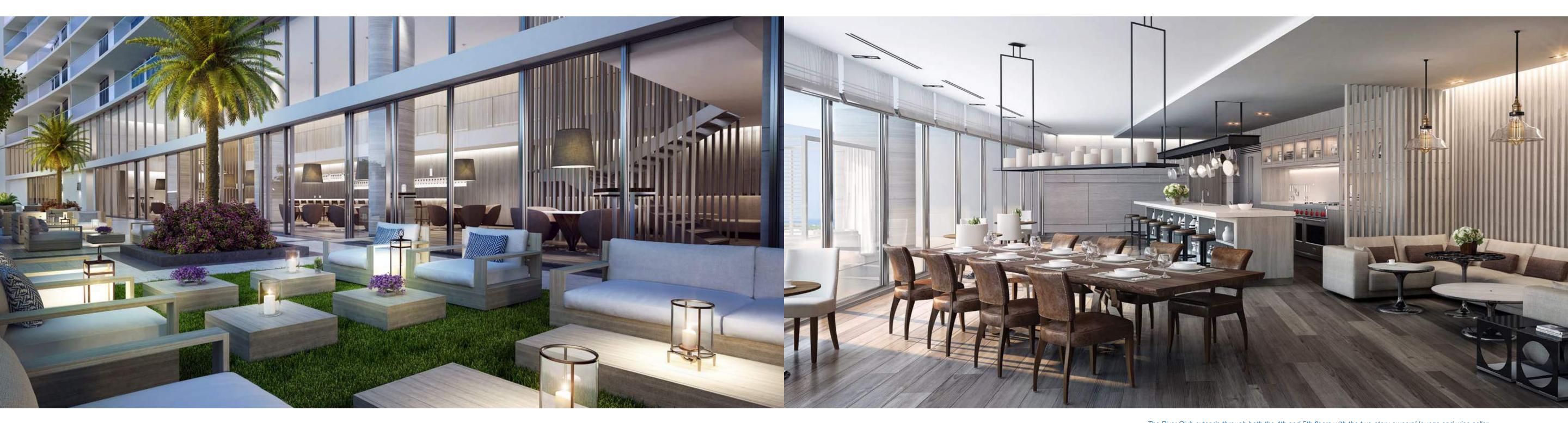

RIVA's riverfront is our own landscaped park and promenade, overlooking the residents' boat slips. Here's where you can launch your paddleboard or kayak, or hop on the RIVA water taxi for a quick trip across to the tennis courts, for shopping at Galleria Mall, or for a sunset cruise to Las Olas.

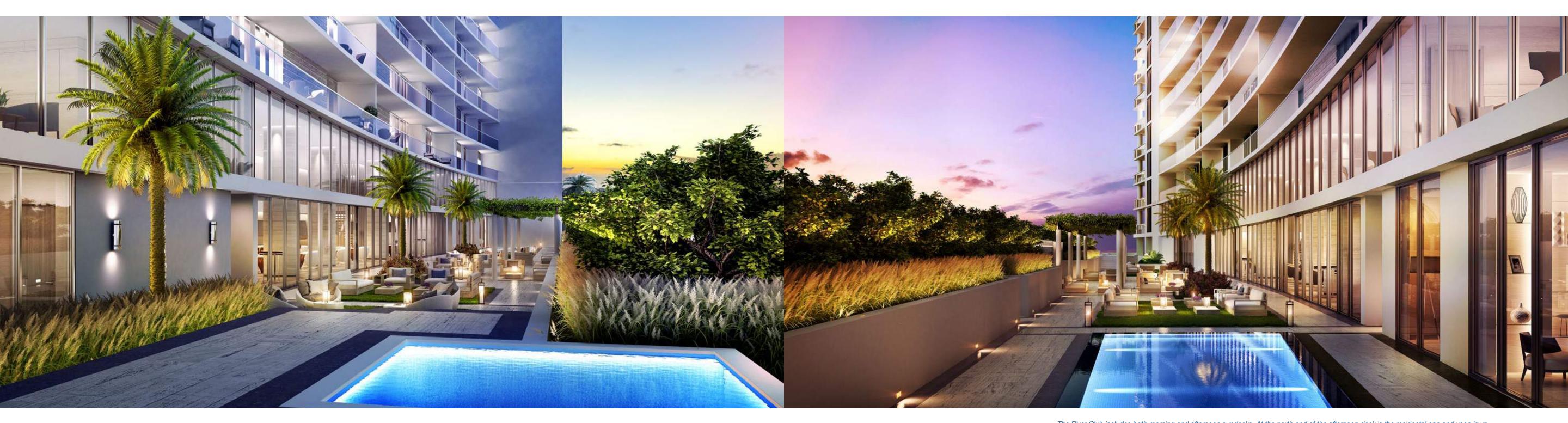
Step off your elevator and enter the residents-only River Club, where the waterview fitness center opens onto the sun deck and 65-foot lap pool.

The River Club extends through both the 4th and 5th floors with the two-story owners' lounge and wine cellar, complemented by the one-of-a-kind Cucina – a dinner party kitchen for you and 20 friends.

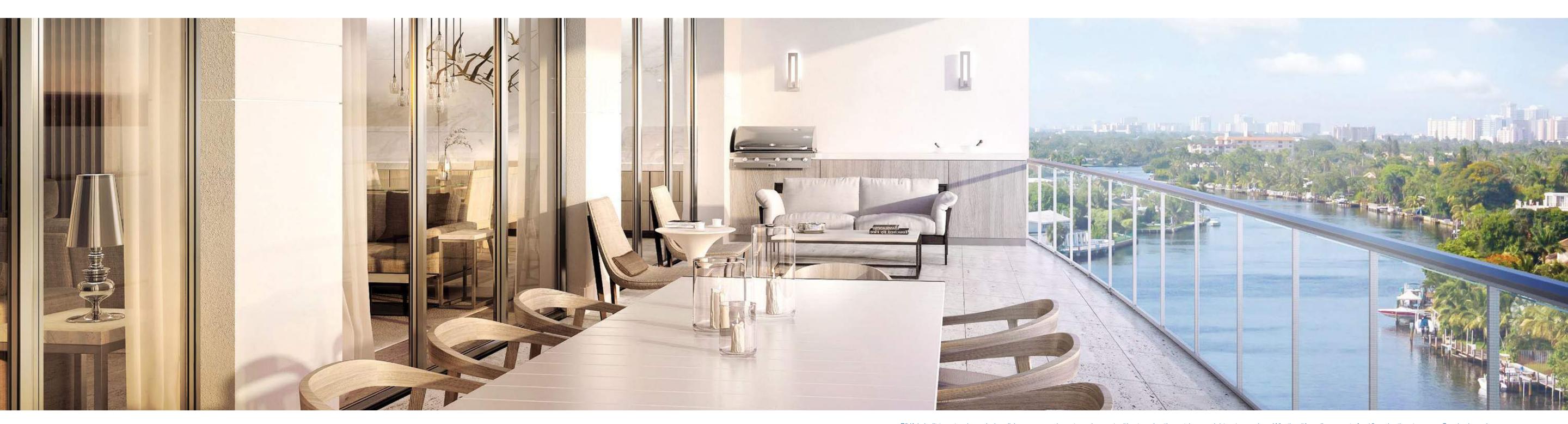

The River Club includes both morning and afternoon sundecks. At the north end of the afternoon deck is the residents' spa and yoga lawn.

At the south end are the guest cabanas and reflecting pool. In between is the cocktail lounge and deck.

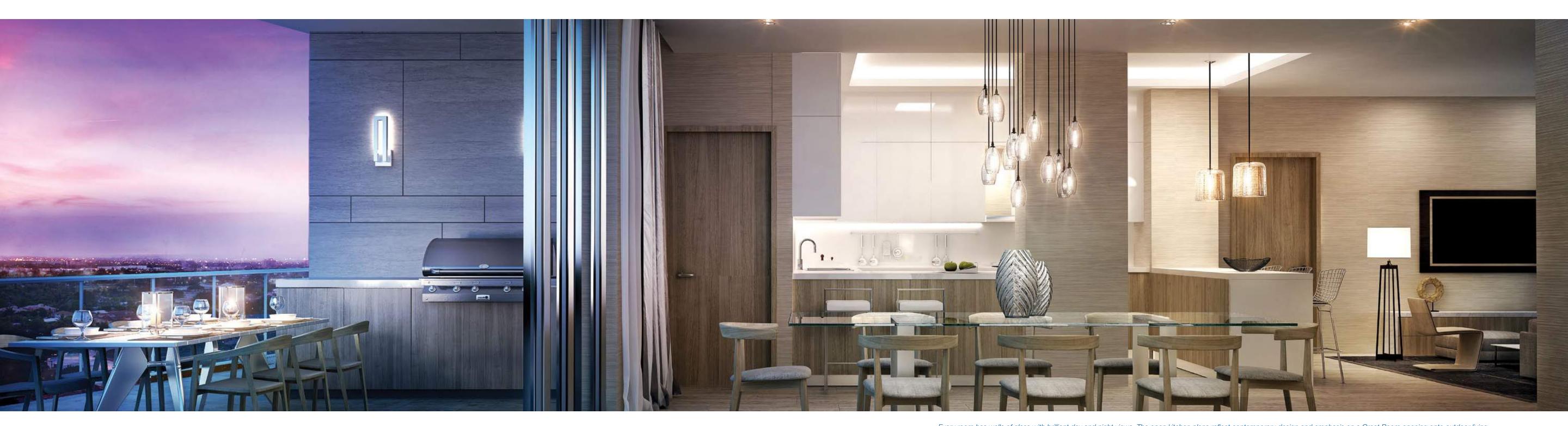


Great Rooms 30 feet wide. Floor-to-ceiling glass 9 feet high. Dinner party-sized dining room. Multiple seating areas. Master suites with dressing areas. Kitchens with large islands.

Every residence at RIVA will surprise you with extra space and possibilities.

"It feels more like a house than a condo" is a reaction we often hear. That's because RIVA's two-bedroom residences average over 2,000 square feet of living space, and our three bedrooms over 3,000 square feet. We even have two-story penthouses with rooftop terraces of more than 2,400 square feet, plus room for a pool.

"The rooms flow so well, you really feel the volume and light."



Every room has walls of glass with brilliant day and night views. The open kitchen plans reflect contemporary design and emphasis on a Great Room opening onto outdoor living.

Sunrise and Sunset Terraces are both combined in some RIVA models, where residences extend all the way through the building, with views to both the ocean and the city.

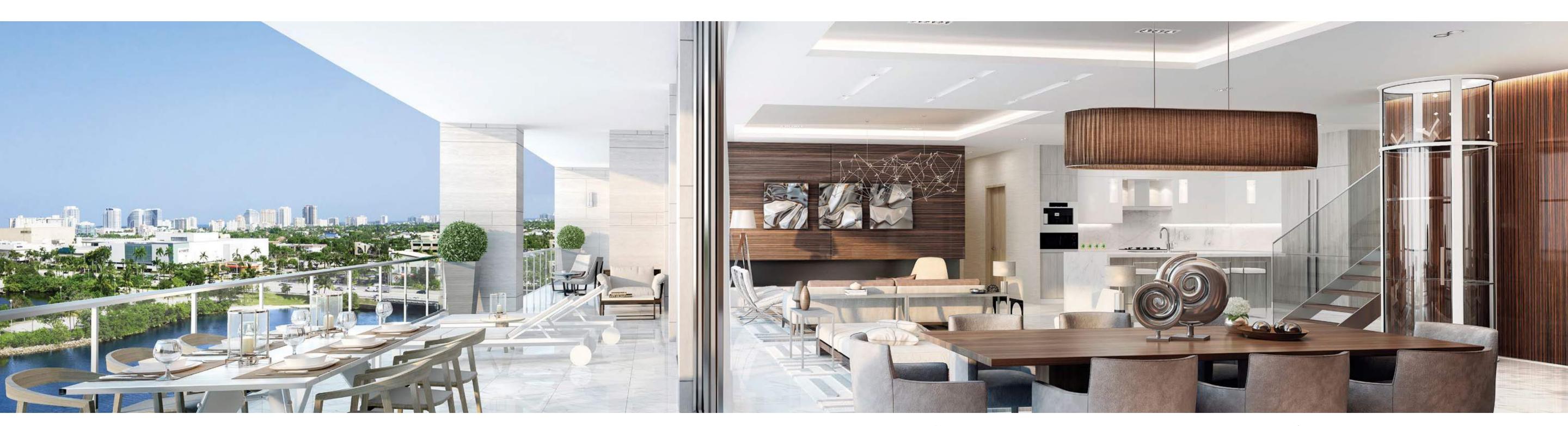
RIVA's unique design is horizontal, not vertical, and stretches north to south along the bank of the river. So homes with terraces on the east are greeted by sunrise over the ocean, and homes with terraces on the west watch the golden sunset over the city.



RIVA's developer told their architect to design fewer, larger residences, and dedicate more space to more amenities, for a smaller number of residents.

So the ground floor has a large, covered arrival court and a 60-foot-wide, two-story lobby. Plus a café and watersports club. Most of the 4th and 5th floors are dedicated to the residents' River Club, with the lap pool and sun deck, gym and spa, two-story lounge, wine room and guest cabanas. All to be shared by only 100 residences.

"The only penthouses with two horizons, two terraces and two floors."



RIVA's penthouses are what you expect a penthouse to be. Not just the top floor, but the top two floors. All of them. So you get two huge terraces, and both ocean and city views.

With two floors, you also get your own elevator – a glass-enclosed pneumatic one that lifts you slowly and tranquilly. Total indoor-outdoor living space runs from over 5,000 to more than 7,000 square feet. There's nothing like these eight penthouses anywhere in Fort Lauderdale.

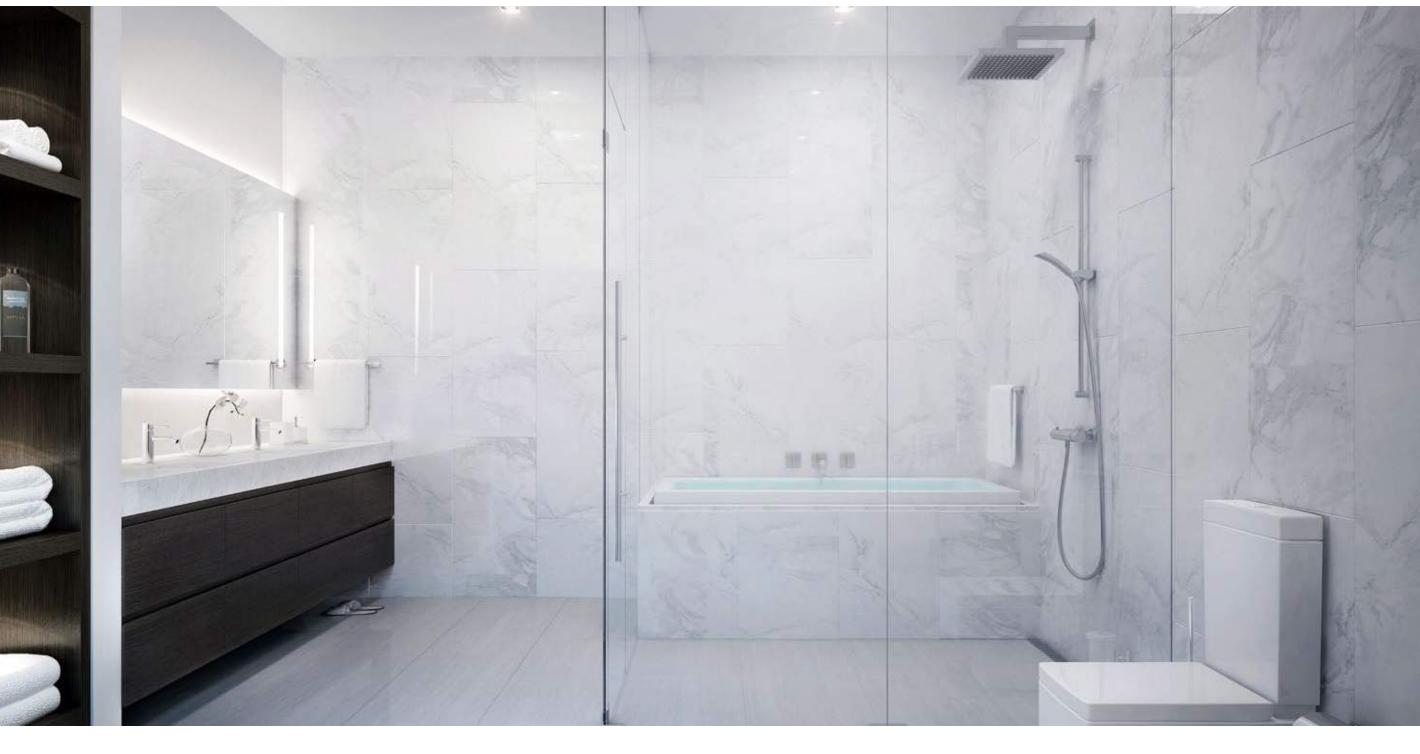

Bradley Deckelbaum is the 4th generation of a family of developers who collectively have been developing residential, commercial and retail properties for over 100 years.

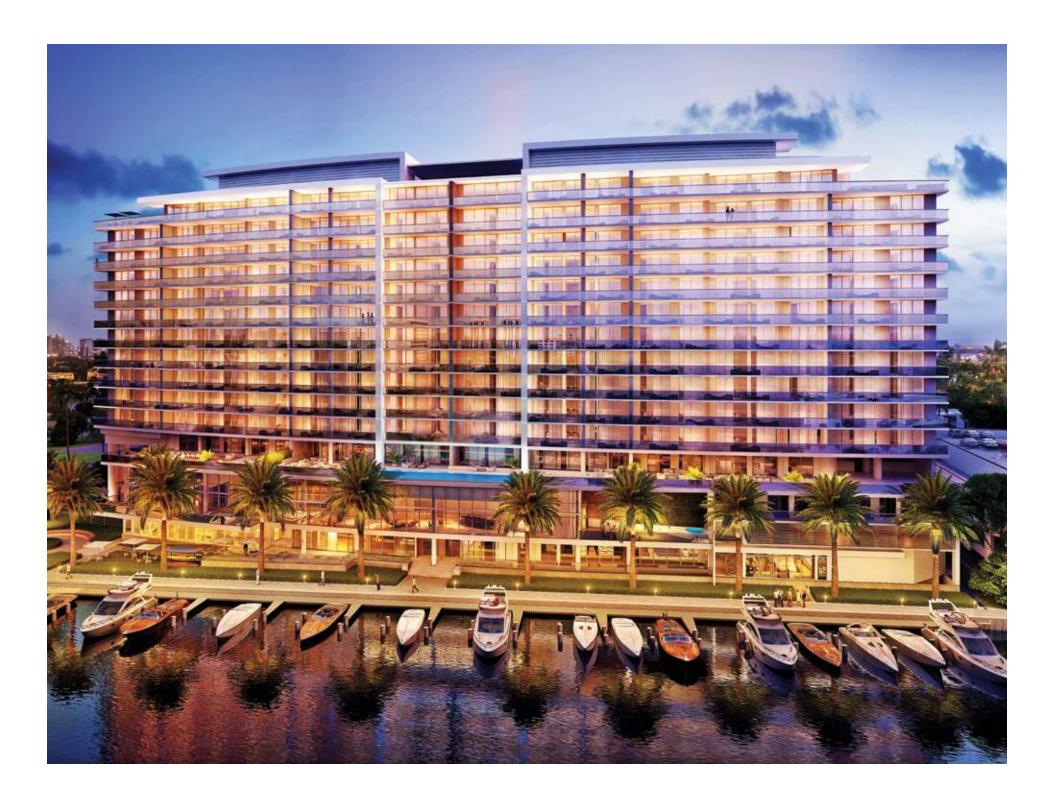

In the late 1970's Gordon and Moe relocated to South Florida, where they directed their efforts to the luxury condominium market, building a reputation always focused on how the purchaser lives in the community, the building and his own private home.

After several years at a New York law firm, Gordon's son Bradley joined in 2002, adding a sensitivity to a broader market and new dimensions to the development concepts.

In Florida, the family has now developed over 2000 homes and condominiums with a value in excess of \$800 million.
