

STATE SENATOR JIM TOMES



 - budget shortfalls?





The U.S. is facing a shortage of teachers in subjects like math, science and special education. Do you think Indiana should direct more school funding specifically to teacher pay?












Would you support or oppose authorizing law enforcement agencies to immediately clear streets and interstates that are being blocked by people protesting illegally?
