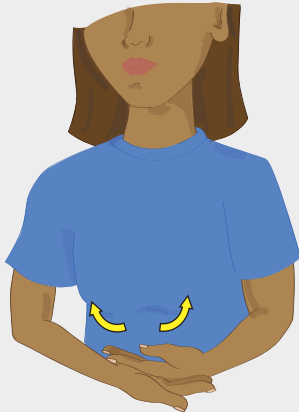


# Infant Sign Language

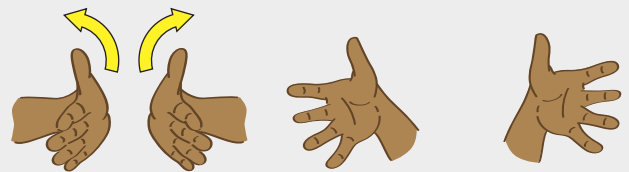
