IMPORTANT NOTES

IMPORTANT NOTES FOR COACHES:

Only NGB accredited coaches are permitted in the tatami area. Coaching passes must be worn and visible before being permitted access to the tatami area.

Anyone wishing to coach at the tatami during the event will have to have NGB accreditation to prove they are aware of the required rules, responsibilities and expected conduct. **Without this accreditation a coach pass will not be issued by the event organiser.** All coaches must register via Sportdata.

Coach: Dress code

Coaches must be in association tracksuits and clearly display their coaching ID badge. Inappropriate dress, as deemed by the chief referee, will be refused access to the competition area. Only coaches adhering to the correct dress code and in possession of a coaching pass will be allowed on the competition area.

Coach: Medical

We record every injury that gives us the slightest concern, however symptoms often occur after the incident and we would ask that the coach or representative informs the medical team of any concerns he or she has at the time of the incident, or anytime after, no matter how trivial it may seem.

We fully intend to have Repechage for WKF CADET, JUNIOR and SENIOR Individual Kata and Kumite categories. However the chief referee has the authority to withdraw repecharge if the time frame becomes critical. Competitors can only compete in their own categories and cannot move up to compete in another category. In the unlikely event of low category entries the organisers reserve the right to amalgamate categories.

Insurance: It is the responsibility of each individual, or parent / guardian of a competitor if under 18 years of age, to have their own insurance cover for the event. Please advise your competitors accordingly regarding insurance cover. It is the responsibility of the clubs/coaches to ensure that all competitors are aware of this and have been advised of adequate cover. Association/club parental consent to compete is also required. This is the responsibility of the association.

Health and Safety issues have been discussed and we try to plan for every eventuality. However this is a busy tournament and due care and attention is required in all areas. Would all coaches/parents ensure their children are properly chaperoned. Karate matches are performed in bare feet, please ensure proper footwear is used in the arena and surrounding areas, especially approaching the mats.

Social Media: We may use Photographs/Video footage of the event for promotional and educational material for our social media platforms including our website. By participating in the event you are consenting to your image being used for social media purposes.

Disclaimer: Karate is a martial art and contact sport. People can and do get injured and we cannot accept responsibility for any such injury, loss or accident arising from your participation in our training, competitions or associated activities and ask that you are aware, agree and accept this by entering or giving permission to enter this event. We should also be notified, in writing, of any medical condition that may have relevance to their participation in karate.

This is the ONLY METHOD for registration for SKGB Events.

It is the responsibility of coaches to ensure that all competitors are registered and are in the correct categories. Competitors are only allowed to compete in their own age/weight/height category and are not allowed to move up a category. Any competitor registered incorrectly will not be allowed to compete. Entries will only be accepted via your coach/association and not from individuals.

Should certain categories fail to meet an acceptable number of entries, or indeed an excess of entries, the event team reserve the right to alter/merge these categories to maintain the integrity of the competion.

Coach Registration: All coaches must register online via Sportdata before the closing date. Coach passes will only be issued on the day to coaches who are NGB accredited and pre-registered via SportData.

Rules of the day

The event will start at 9.00am prompt with staggered start times throughout the day. A full event schedule confirming start times will be published on Sportdata prior to the event.

Competitors in the first categories of the day should be ready to start at 9.00am prompt. For all other categories competitors should be in the arena a minimum of 1 hour prior to category scheduled start time. Should the event run ahead of schedule category start times may be brought forward.

The following WKF approved equipment is compulsory for all WKF kumite categories and recommended for all other kumite categories:

Mitts red for AKA and blue for AO

Shin pads and foot protectors red for AKA and blue for AO

Gum Shield

Body protector [compulsory for 14 years and above]

Female chest protector (compulsory for 14 years and above, this is worn as well as the body protector.)

Kata

Scoring will be by flag system.

U14 years Novice - 9th Kyu — 5th Kyu Heian/Pinan kata only Can repeat

U14 years Advanced - 4th Kyu & Above Free choice of kata Alternate between a minimum of two kata

Para Kata Free choice of kata Can repeat

WKF categories 14 years+ WKF rules

Kumite

U14 years and Veteran Bout duration: 1.30 minutes

WKF scoring rules but no contact will be allowed to the head, face or neck with either the hands or feet Any contact however slight, will be penalised.

WKF rules for all WKF Kumite categories

Weight/Height check in & Licence check

We will operate weight/height & licence checks. Any competitor found registered in the incorrect category will not be allowed to compete. We cannot move competitors to another category if they fail the weight/height checks.

All competitors must produce a valid licence on the day of the competition. If licence is not valid or not presented you will not be allowed to compete.
