OGHS Advanced Placement Courses

*** Courses that can take an AP test at end of year, scores are submitted to college, colleges determine their college equivalency for credit approval. AP Scores are on a scale of 1 to 5.*

The following classes are the in-person AP Course available at Oak Glen.

- AP Calculus BC
- AP Statistics
- AP English Literature
- AP Government / Politics

Dual Credits - WVNCC Courses

***Course that earn college credits at West Virginia Northern Community College. Cost is \$25 per credit hour with a \$25 registration fee per semester ** Student must earn a C or better to earn a college credit ** A student must request a separate WVNCC College transcript from WV Northern upon graduation to accompany college applications.*

The following courses are dual credits that are taken at Oak Glen and are also a WVNCC credits. The dual credits are limited to this list (see below of additional WVNCC course work that is an Early Entrance Course via WVNCC)

- US History 110 - Blackboard / Virtual - Fall Semester (junior / senior year only)
3 credit hours
- US History 111 - Blackboard / Virtual - Spring Semester (junior / senior year only)
3 credit hours
- 12th - English 101 - Blackboard / Virtual - Fall Semester (senior year only)
3 credit hours
- 12th - English 102 - Blackboard / Virtual - Spring Semester (senior year only)
3 credit hours
- Math 279 - Calculus AB - Adjunct Instruction/Corbin 5 credit hours
- Math 280 - Calculus BC - Adjunct Instruction / Corbin 4 credit hours
- Math 210 - Statistics - Adjunct Instruction / Corbin 3 credit hours
- Art 150 - Art History - Adjunct Instruction / Greathouse 3 credit hours

Note – Both AP and WVNCC/OGHS Dual credits are an accelerated GPA credit... stating if you earn an A it is 5 points on a 4.0 GPA scale.

WVNCC - Early Entrance Program Information

High school students may attend West Virginia Northern while still in high school any semester after the end of their sophomore year. This option is also available for home-schooled students. Early Entrance students who successfully complete college-level courses may use the credits toward graduation at Northern and/or have the credits transferred to other colleges and universities.

Also, WVNCC offers a College 101 class –

This is a pass or fail course that will earn a K (pass or fail) grade on the Northern transcript. The standard \$25 per credit hour and a \$25 processing fee per semester applies. So, if this were the only course being taken the total would be \$50. There is no text or workbook. The enrollment process is straight forward, submit application, registration form, and transcripts. There are no placement requirements for this course. It is open for all sophomores, juniors, and seniors. The CRN is 30504
