The round robin format ensures that every participant competes against all other contestants. This guarantees a higher number of matches per athlete compared to single-elimination formats, where a single loss can eliminate a competitor. More matches mean athletes have more opportunities to showcase their skills, leading to a more accurate and comprehensive assessment of their abilities.

In a round robin format, consistency and perseverance are crucial. Athletes can recover from an initial loss and still succeed, promoting a fairer competition where the best performers over multiple bouts are recognized.

dance with the WKF rules is mandatory.
Body protector can but does not have to be
worn.

Fighting times:

U12, U14: 1,5 min
U16, U18, Master: 2 min
U21, Seniors: 3 min

According to the rules of the WKF and the
DKV, coaches may only act as coaches in
a tracksuit (not a leisure suit) and with the
official coach card. Coaches must be regis-
tered via Sportdata.
