On behalf of the SEDiv SCCA, I want to thank you for being a participant in our annual Majors/Double SARRC races at Roebling Road. I know everyone is looking forward to returning to racing in the north end of the Division. A great deal of planning hours by a lot of dedicated people have made this event possible. I know everyone would like things to return to normal, but we are going to have to endure a little more before it does. Here are our plans for the weekend.

When you arrive at the track, all registration will be outside the paddock at the registration building behind the control tower. If you have been inside for the test day, you must come out and register. Registration will be no contact. If you have an annual waiver and photo id, please show it and you will receive an arm band. If you do not have an annual waiver, you must sign the waiver. There will be a supply of pens that are sanitized. Once you have your arm band, you will proceed to another table where you will record your name and your telephone #. Your temperature will be taken and if it is under 100.4 degrees, you will be admitted to the paddock. If it is over 100.4, you will be seated in a shady area for 15 minutes and you will be tested again. If your temperature is still over 100.4, you will not be admitted at that time.

Once in the paddock, please set up your paddock in an orderly manner. You will be required to wear a mask on your face anytime you leave your own paddock area. If you do not have a mask when you arrive at the track, we will provide you with one. Registration will have a supply. Anytime you leave your paddock and are within 10 feet of anyone not on your immediate crew, you will be required to cover your nose and mouth with a mask. You can proceed to tech with the info given you by registration for tech. If you need an annual, please contact me and I will advise how we will handle. If no annual needed, please keep you distance when at tech. Minimum distance is 6 feet.

The track will be serving food all weekend. Concession stand orders maybe placed from their menu by texting 912-800-3265. Please include your name and pick up time. No one will be allowed to sit in the enclosed area. We will have tables and chairs set up for dining outside. We will also have a hospitality tent set up where you can get a menu plus your results, trophies, cold water and ice cream all day. At the end of the day on Saturday, the track is preparing a box dinner of rotisserie chicken, pulled pork, potatoes and bread. You must sign up for this on motorsportreg.com. You can sit at any tables set up, bring your own or take the food back to your pit. There will also be liquid refreshments. There will be" reachers" for seniors for all to use to pick bottled water and other refreshments from the ice tubs. Of course, there will be hand sanitizers everywhere for you to use. Please use them. And don't forget, we will give a free entry fee to the best decorated race team table. That is a \$395 prize. We will have live entertainment with easy listening music.

For post race impound, please drive your car across the scales and proceed into the impound area. Only the driver will be permitted in impound. Once you have parked and exited the car, please leave impound and go to the tent or under the shed. We will have ice towels and cold water there for you. Only tech officials will be allowed in the impound area. If there is a need for a crew person in the impound area, we will advise. Once impound is completed, cars can be removed by one person. Masks must be worn in the tech area post race.

I know some of this may seem like over kill. However, we are concerned about your safety and the safety of all our volunteers. We want to insure everyone has a safe weekend. We are sure all of you are just as concerned and will help us make this another great race weekend.
