- 8% of Madison County residents lack basic literacy skills.
- Fewer than 17% of county residents have college degrees.
- Almost 30% of Madison County children live in poverty.
- Of Indiana's 92 counties, Madison County ranks 73rd in social and economic factors such as education, employment, and income.
- Even more discouraging, we rank 91st in health behaviors that include smoking, diet, exercise, etc.
- Although more than 50% of our population is female, less than 25% of firms are women-owned.
- Last year Alternatives Inc. served 345 domestic/sexual abuse victims and their children from Madison County.
