The organisers of the event (or any of its officials or members) will not be liable or responsible for any personal injury.

Coaches and team leaders are responsible for ensuring that all participants are physically fit, prepared, and capable of coping with the tournament. We strongly recommend proper medical and accident insurance. Competitors compete at their own risk.

5 RULES AND DRAW

The following rules apply:

- JJIF competition rules (in their latest versions) and the Organization and Sporting code of JJIF Version 3.2 (OSC).¹
- We appeal to all participants to respect the fair-play and JJIF book of ethics

5.1 Draw modus

The seeding and draw will be made on Wednesday May 25th 2022 at 21:30 – 22:00 by Zoom, link will follow to all registered officials.

Immediately after the draw has been finalised, the categories will be made available online on the Sportdata Event Website. JJNOs have the right to request minor changes² in the following 2 hours (from 21:00 to 22:00), in writing, to the organising committee.

Major changes³ must be requested according to the following⁴:

- At official international championships, **no redraw** is possible, except for unforeseen cases when the JJEU Board may decide on a redraw.
- A redraw can be requested max. 2 hours after the draw was published but, in any case, before the start of the competition, **in writing**, to the JJEU Sports Director.

Seeding regulations of the JJIF will be observed. For the seeding, JJIF will use the world ranking list and registration to the event from Wednesday May 25th 2022. The JJNOs are responsible for making sure all points are correct in the raking list until this day.

5.2 Appeal and Challenge

Will be applied as defined in JJIF OSC 3.2, § 1.5 Challenge and Appeal.

6 RIGHT TO PARTICIPATE AND CATEGORIES

Based on the JJIF OSC 3.2, Paragraph § 3.2. Entries of Competitors:

Each JJNO may enter two (2) contestants in each category for these European Championship Adults, for masters we can accept four (4) in each category.

6.1 Categories

The age following age categories⁵ will be allowed to participate in this event

Name	Description	Year of birth for this event
Adults (+18)	Older than 18 years	2004 ⁶ and older (must be 18 at the event)
Masters (+35)	35 and older	1986 and older

Official JJIF Weight categories will be used7

7 COVID 19 RELATED MEASURES

A face mask is required when entering busy places, a PCR test for flying to your home country is only necessary when the destination country requires this. You need a PCR test to enter Israel.

8.2 Participation Fee (Adults and Masters)

€ 150 per individual athlete – and € 150 per duo/show couple (€ 60 participation / € 10 Doping Free contribution / € 85 Referee contribution)

Late entry and late payment fees will be applied.

- * Change (of an injured) competitor until registration deadline: free
- * Change (of an injured) competitor after registration deadline (in the same category): € 10
- * Change of the category of an athlete: € 10
- * Late entry: € 10
- * Additional entering of a competitor on site: € 50

Participation fee Masters: € 150 per individual athlete – and € 150 per duo/show couple (€ 60 participation / € 10 Doping Free contribution / € 85 Referee contribution)

9 ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

All members should make their competitors aware that there could be doping control for several athletes. The WADA code for Doping Free sports will be applied. By entering the Championship, you accept the JJIF Anti-Doping regulations⁸.

If you are participating in the Championship and are taking any medication or plan to take any medication, please check with your doctor whether your medicine contains any substances on WADA's 2022 Prohibited List

You will need a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) if it does. JJEU automatically recognises all TUEs issued by National Anti-Doping Agency (NADAs), so please contact your NADA if you need a TUE and do not already have one.

If you have any difficulty applying for a TUE through your NADO or there is no NADO in your country, please contact the JJIF.

10 COMPETITION DRESSING AND PERSONAL REQUIREMENTS & ADVERTISING

The national federations purchase the back numbers for all JJEU events, at the following link, from Ju-Sports, the premium sponsor of the JJEU:

The JJNOs are then responsible for giving the back numbers to the athletes so that they can apply them to their Gi's prior to the competition. The national federations must pay the back

numbers for their athletes by themselves. Participating without an official back number is not allowed.

Please observe the regulations of the JJIF as far as advertising on the Gi is concerned9.

11 REFEREES

The organising committee will take care of the referees working in this event, which means booking flights and hotel and transportation will be handled and covered by OC and JJEU organisation committee.

The Technical Commission (referee director of each Discipline and Sport Director) will decide about participation in consideration of Discipline [s], Availability, License level, Evaluation and Ranking, Gender equality aspects, country. Continental and age mix.

12 COACHES & MEDICAL PERSONNEL FROM JJNOS

12.1 Coaches

All official coaches should receive their accreditation cards during accreditation. Teams without an official coach will participate without coaching (no athlete or other officials will be allowed to enter the field of play unless they register as coaches). All Coaches should attend the briefing meeting (digital) on Tuesday, 26 April 2022).

12.2 Medical personnel

JJNOS may have¹⁰ its medical personnel. To receive an accreditation card as medical personnel the attendance at the medical meeting¹¹ is mandatory

12.3 Dress code

Coaches and medical personnel coming on the FOP must wear official team dresses¹², shorts, flip-flops, hats are not allowed.

Filming (including mobile videos) inside the FOP is not allowed without press accreditation.

According to GAISF guidelines, every competitor who has won a medal has to attend the ceremony to receive their trophy in person¹³.

13 FLAGS AND ANTHEMS

The head of each delegation, or designated responsible of each national federation, must check the flag and the national anthem during the accreditation process.

14 FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

The organisation of the travel to Israel and Travel expenses and are the responsibility of the participating countries.

Each federation must pay the cost of the accommodation and the participation to the local organiser.

Payment must be done by bank transfer until Thursday April 28th 2022 or take pre-approval that you will pay cash at the official registration and accreditation.

No accommodation or registration refund for participants not attending the Championship will be made.

15.1Important information about your travel to Israel

Be aware that the ticket you received at the border control, see example here:



This ticket always have to be carried with you.

By leaving the Country you have to be aware that you have to handover a PCR test not older than 48 hours old. PCR tests has to be paid by yourself or your federation. Gurion Airport, Tel Aviv Israel is the recommended airport. At this airport LOC will be available to guide all guests to the destination.

16 RIGHT TO PARTICIPATE AND CATEGORIES

Athletes must be presented and registered by their National Federation. All competitors must have a legal passport of the nation they represent in the championship and sports passport of their respective nation! Medical certificate, insurance, gender control and the like are the responsibility of the national federation registering the athletes.

Following 2019 JJIF TC and Congress decision in Abu Dhabi: max 2 persons/couples per category are allowed, with an overall quota of 14 (ten) women and 14 (ten) men for Jiu-Jitsu (Ne Waza), 14 (ten) women and 14 (ten) men for Fighting, 6 (six) couples for Duo and 6 (six) couples for Show.

Competitors that will reach the proper age in the present year (from 1.1 to 12.31) have the right of participation in the designated category (valid for fighting, jiu-jitsu (ne waza), duo and show systems). No athlete younger than 18 years old is allowed to compete.

Control of entries and issuing of accreditation cards will take place at the main official hotel in a time frame starting at Sunday July the 4th till Friday July the 9th, during registration and accreditation. At least one team official must attend in time to confirm the presence of all athletes and officials. The team official must be able to show all official documents and passports of all team members (copies are accepted).

An accreditation card shall be issued to all competitors, officials and crew members and should be carried at all times. Be aware that an accreditation can only be used by athletes on their

competition day. If an athlete compete in several discipline's he receives an accreditation for every competition day he has to play.

Duo system:

Men, Women and Mixed

Show system:

Men, Women and Mixed

Fighting system:

- Men -56 kg, -62 kg, -69 kg, -77 kg, -85 kg, -94 kg, +94 kg
- Women -45 kg, -48 kg, -52 kg, -57 kg, -63 kg, -70 kg, +70 kg

Jiu-Jitsu Ne Waza:

- Men -56, -62, -69, -77, -85, -94, +94
- Women -45 kg, -48 kg, -52 kg, -57 kg, -63 kg, -70 kg, +70 kg

If a competitor participates in the Duo competition, he/she is allowed to be part of a mixed couple and of a couple of his/her gender. The athlete is allowed to compete on the same tournament in Show, also part of a mixed couple and of a couple of his/her gender. The organizer will observe that the Duo men and women are scheduled for one competition day, while the mixed duo is scheduled for the other day. The same is valid for the Show system. Be 100% sure that the picture of your team members are uploaded in Sportdata. Without picture people will not be allowed in the hall and warmup, food areas and other sport specific areas around the hall.
