Guidelines and Policies for Visiting the Museum

- Feel free to look, gaze, or linger, but please do not touch any works of art—fingerprints leave behind damaging oils. Keep your hands to yourself and be sure to walk carefully so you do not bump something accidentally.
- Please stay at least twelve inches away from labels, display cases, and gallery wall surfaces to help keep the Museum clean for other guests to enjoy.
- Leave coats, backpacks, and large bags in your vehicle or at the Front Desk.
- Only pencils may be used in the galleries.
- No food, drink, gum, or smoking in the Museum.
- Think twice before making or receiving cell phone calls in the Museum—it is a distraction to others.
- Service animals are permitted in the Museum. Pets are not permitted on the Museum campus.
- Feel free to take videos and photos without flash or additional lighting. No photography is permitted in Special Exhibitions unless otherwise noted.
- Weapons are not permitted in the Museum (exception: law enforcement officers).
