• The new Junior Driver Program (JDP).

"The 2018 Junior Driver Program (JDP) is focused in four areas: course standards, driver instruction, kart rules/inspection and event operation. The training programs and materials will aim to educate Region officials on JDP best practices and procedures. The completion of this training will result in the issuance of licenses to Solo event officials that will certify Regions to be sanctioned to operate a JDP at their Solo events.

• Solo Safety Steward Training Seminar (classroom). Attending a Solo Safety Steward Seminar is required as the first phase of obtaining a Solo Safety Steward License and is also required a continuing education for Solo Safety Steward License renewals.
