

Introduction

Pirursiivik Project is an initiative in Inukjuak that began in 2017 between Makivik Corporation, the One Drop Foundation and a community investment from the Royal Bank of Canada Foundation. “Pirursiivik” means “a place to grow stuff” in Inuktitut.

Multiple programs and collaborations have been developed through the project to address food insecurity and promote healthy habits and creativity in Nunavik. One important aspect is to explore and know the plants that already grow around the community.

During our on-the-land activities in the summer of 2020, we took several photos of the plants we identified, and we turned our photos into images that can be colored and enjoyed by all ages. We hope this book inspires you to learn more about the plants around your community.
